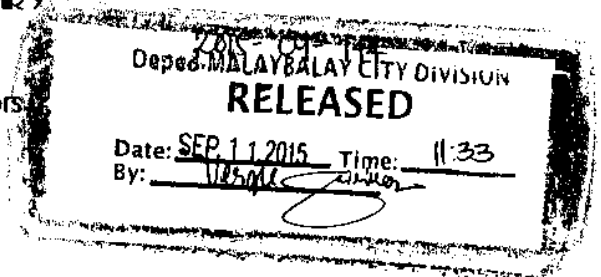

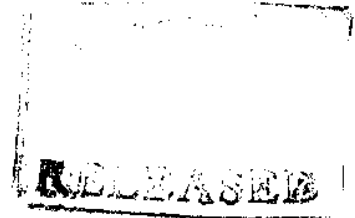

**General Guidelines**

1. The participants should be a bona fide student / currently enrolled in a private school registered as member under the PRISSAAP Region 10 SY 2015-2016.
2. Each school shall fill up the registration form attached and email to: [prissaap10@gmail.com](mailto:prissaap10@gmail.com) on or before August 28 to avail of the early registration rates..
3. Student-participants will wear school ID's and school uniforms during the opening ceremony. Respective attires as required/prescribed will be worn during the contest proper.
4. Congress ID's will be issued after authentication with school ID's.
5. Each participant is required to submit the Parent's /Guardian's waiver to his/her respective school.
6. A student is allowed to join in ONE contest only since different contests will be held simultaneously
7. Each contest will have separate venue and this will be announced during the opening ceremony.
8. Ranking system should be used in identifying the winner of every contest ( except for Sports) . In case of a tie, the Chairman of the Board of Judges, has the right to break the tie.
9. All student-participants should be duly registered.
10. The rules and mechanics of the different contests should be strictly observed. Otherwise, failure to do so can be a ground for disqualification.

**Rules/Mechanics and Criteria**

**Poem/Essay Writing in English & Filipino**  
**(contests will be considered separate)**

1. Only one (1) participant is allowed per school / per contest ( one for Essay Writing in English ; one for Filipino ; and one for Poem Writing in English and one in Filipino)
2. The theme of the writing ( Poem and essay) contest will be given during the break out orientation.
3. Time allotment is one hour.
4. Paper shall be provided. The participants shall bring their own pens/ball pens.
5. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

Organization of Ideas	30 %
Mechanics (Grammar and Usage)	15%
Creativity (Literary Style)	15%

### DANCE SPORTS

1. Only one couple ( male and female) is allowed per school.
2. The participant will undergo an elimination round to qualify them in the final round. Only five ( 5) pairs will qualify in the final round.
3. During the elimination round, the partner will render their dance using their choice of songs. A CD copy of the music for the dance entry should be submitted before the performance. USB , tablet or cell phone copy is not allowed.
4. Latin American is the category of the competition which is composed of:
  - a. Cha cha cha
  - b. Samba
  - c. Rhumba
  - d. Paso Doble
  - e. Jive
5. Each dance must be executed in one and a half (1 ½ ) minutes except for jive which must be executed in a minimum of one (1) minute.
6. A couple who bumps into another couple or stumble down during the competition will be disqualified in the contest.
7. The line direction should be followed during the competition especially in samba.
8. The judging of the couple begins when they adopt their dancing position and ends only when the music stops. The judges must only check their marks during the entire dance and amend them if necessary.
9. If the couple stops dancing while the music is still being played, the couple will be ranked last in the dance. If this happens during the final round, the couple will also be ranked last in the dance.
10. Couples must be judged solely on their performance in the specific dance at the specific time.
11. For attire:

Ladies:

  - a. The area between the hip and the panty line, plus the back and breast must be covered. No see through materials are allowed on these areas. No high-cut panties or tangas.
  - b. When standing, the skirt should cover the panty completely.
  - c. Any color, except flesh(skin color) is acceptable.
  - d. Panty should be black or the same color of the dress.
  - e. Use of religious symbol as accessory or jewelry is not allowed.

Men:

  - a. Black or midnight blue trousers; black or midnight blue or white shirt on top. Any other top is allowed if it is the color of the material of the lady's dress. The shirt or top has to be tucked on. No sleeveless shirts or tops are allowed.
  - b. The shirt can be opened down to the end of the breastbone. See through materials can be used as the decoration but not as the basic material.
  - c. Vest, jacket or bolero of the same color of trousers is optional.
  - d. Tie, bow tie or scarf matching the trousers of the top is optional. If the scarf is worn, it has to be tied and tucked inside the shirt.
  - e. Combinations of different materials of the same color are allowed.
  - f. Short hairstyle is preferred.
12. Non-adherence to the attire rule would mean disqualification.
13. The decision of the judges is final.

#### VOCAL DUET

1. Only one pair is allowed per school. It can be either male or female or combination of both.
2. The participants will undergo an elimination round to qualify them in the final round. For the elimination round, the pair is going to sing only the chorus of the chosen song in a cappella.
3. Only five (5) pairs will qualify in the final round.
4. For the final round, the piece is either foreign or an OPM composition. A hard copy of the lyrics of the song ( in 3 copies, short sized bond paper ) should be submitted to the committee an hour before the contest.
5. The soloist must be accompanied by a CD . Videogke, multiplex, USB, tablet, cell pone downloaded copy is not allowed.
6. There shall be no time limit in the performance.
7. Attire is decent and presentable. There should be no school identification.
8. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

#### ACOUSTIC DUO

1. Only one pair is allowed per school. It can be either male or female or combination of both.
2. They should be accompanied by a guitar. It can either be one partner or both of them will play the guitar. For the vocals, it can either be only one partner or both of them will sing.
3. The participants will undergo elimination round to qualify them in the final rounds. For the elimination round, the pair is going to sing only the chorus of the chosen song.
4. Only five (5) pairs will qualify in the final round.
5. For the final round, the piece is either foreign or an OPM composition. Only one complete song is allowed. Mashed -song type is not allowed.
6. There shall be no time limit in the performance.
7. Attire should be decent and presentable. There should be no school identification.
8. The decision of the Baord of Judges is FINAL.

1. Only one (1) participant is allowed per school.
2. The theme of the Poster Making contest will be given during the break out orientation.
3. One a half (1 ½) hours is the allotted time of the poster making. If a participant can't finish his/her work after the allotted time, he/she will be disqualified.
4. Any coloring materials are allowed. Combination of different media is allowed.
5. The participants should provide their own materials: 1/8 size illustration board ( has the option if the participant will use the white or black portion ) and coloring materials.
6. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

1. Develop sportsmanship and camaraderie among the private schools of Region 10 through Football.
2. Prepare our Pupils/Students for national competitions as well as International competitions.

**II. Registration:** This league will cater 120 teams only for high school category and on a first come-first serve basis.

**III. Requirements (athletes and coaches/in-charge):**

- a. Filled up declaration and waiver forms;
- b. 2 pcs 2X2 picture;
- c. Photocopy of a certified birth certificate by NSO;
- d. Certification from the Principal that athletes are enrolled for the school year 2015-2016.

**IV. Rules and Regulations**

- a. Cut-off Year:  
High School - January 2000 (15 years old/ on or after January 1, 2000 will be qualified)
- b. The teams will be placed into brackets of four (4) teams each. They will play in a single round robin format ensuring all teams of at least three (3) games. Top 1 team will advance to the "sweet qualifiers" where they will play on a knock-out system. Winners will advance to the quarterfinals and the top 4 teams will advance to the Semi-finals. The two (2) losing teams will play for 2<sup>nd</sup> runner up while the two (2) winning teams will advance to the finals where they will play for the championship round.
- c. Registration form shall be duly accomplished and signed by the principal/registrar with school seal.

d. A school may register more than one team in high school. One team will be composed of 10 players. The game will be a 7 vs 7 format with open substitution. A "default" is called upon a team when the players are not rallied to the pitch assigned with at least five (5) players.

c. Registration Fees: High School - Php1,000.00 per team of 10 players.

### 2. VENUE AND REGISTRATION

- a. Games will be played at MGV Sports Complex at Villarin, Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City
- b. All participating teams should present photocopies of players' NSO -- certified birth certificates.

### 3. AGE GROUPS

- a. Under 15 -- Maximum of 10 players (7-aside with Goalkeeper)
- b. Under 11 -- Maximum of 10 Players (7-aside with Goalkeeper)

### 4. ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

- a. Under 15 - Born January 1, 2000 onwards
- b. Under 11 -- Born January 1, 2004 onwards

### 5. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The teams in every age group will be placed into brackets of four (4) teams each. They will play in a single round robin format ensuring all teams of at least three (3) games. Top 1 players will advance to the "sweet qualifiers" where they will play on a knock-out system. Winners will advance to the quarterfinals and the top 4 teams will advance to the Semi-finals. The two (2) losing teams will play for 2<sup>nd</sup> runner up while the two (2) winning teams will advance to the finals where they will play for the championship round.

### 6. MATCH REGULATIONS

- a. All games will be played in 7 A-side.
- b. Flying substitution is allowed.
- c. 5 players are needed to start the game.
- d. All games should have a Goalkeeper.
- e. No Off-side
- f. Pass back to the Goalkeeper is allowed by the six-second rule applied.
- g. Kick-in will be applied
- h. Goalkeeper can hold the ball only inside the Penalty Box.
- i. No goals from throw-in, kick-in, goal kicks and kick-off unless the ball is touched by another player.
- j. No volley kicks only a throw from the Goalkeeper.
- k. A goal kick maybe taken when the ball goes out of the goal line.
- l. Defaulting time is 3 mins.
- m. In case of default, 2 Goals will be awarded to the present team or score of 2-0
- n. If given 1 Yellow Card by the referee means -- WARNING
- o. 2 Yellow Cards in the same game -- out of the game and 1 game suspension.
- p. Direct Red Card -- Out of the Game immediately and 1 game suspension.
- q. The List of players submitted is the final and official line-up for the team.
- r. A player dropped from the final and official line-up due to injury, non-participation of player, withdrawal of the player or refusal of the player to play can be replaced provided that proper documents will be submitted to the commissioner.
- s. A player who is out of the final and official line-up due to disciplinary infraction cannot be replaced.
- t. Time : 12 -15 mins. Straight depending on the team entries.
- u. FIFA RULES APPLIES!

**7. DURATION OF MATCH**

- a. All matches in the elimination round and quarterfinals will be played straight in 12-15 minutes.
- b. In case of a tie in the sweet-qualifiers to quarterfinals, a penalty shoot-out will apply to break the tie (3 kickers for all teams).
- c. Semi-finals and final matches will be played straight in 12-15 minutes. In case of a tie, a 5-minute extension time will be given. After the extension and still on a tie, a penalty shoot-out will be applied to break the tie.

**8. PROTEST ON ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYER**

Protest against the qualification of players who take part in the tournament shall be submitted to the commissioner not later than the next game of the team.

A Player caught over age will mean all games he/she played will be defaulted in favor of the opposing teams. The Player will not be allowed in the tournament.

**9. MATCH POINTS DISTRIBUTION**

- a. WIN = 3 points
- b. Draw = 1 point
- c. Loss = 0 point

**10. SYSTEM TO BREAK TIE**

In the event that 2 or more teams are equal on points, the following system shall be applied to break a tie:

- a. Goal Difference
- b. Greater number of Goals scored
- c. Result of Match between the teams concerned (winner over the other).
- d. Kicks from the penalty marks if the teams involved are still on the field play (result of the match between teams concerned).
- e. Drawing of lots (toss coin)

**11. SYSTEM TO DETERMINE WILDCARD/KNOCK-OUT ROUND**

- a. If there are more than one (1) team that loses their Quarter Finals game through penalty shootout. The team with the highest number of goals during the regular time shall prevail.
- b. If there is still a tie after option a, then a toss coin will settle.
- c. In the event that all losing quarterfinalist lost their game during the regular time, team with the highest number of goals scored shall prevail.
- d. In case of a tie in option c – then a toss coin will settle.
