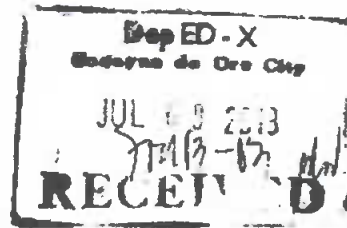

Dear Secretary Luistro,

Peace!

I am writing your good office to inform you of the malicious text messages circulating recently which named me as the primary author of a bill that allegedly aims to remove the salaries of teachers during summer break.

For the record, there is no such bill existing in the legislative index of the Senate and I will never advocate for such measure.

Through the years, I have worked toward uplifting the lives and welfare of our teachers. I introduced bills which I hope would have tremendous impacts on the professional and economic aspects of their lives. In fact, I am one of the authors of the latest Salary Standardization Law which upgraded the salaries of our teachers and other government employees.

I also filed a bill that would increase the minimum salary grade of public school teachers from Salary Grade 10 to Salary Grade 20, which is around P36, 000 based on the latest tranche of the Salary Standardization Law. Also, I introduced a bill that would create plantilla positions for volunteer teachers who have continuously served for five years

Rest assured that I will remain steadfast in our commitment in championing the cause of our teachers. Those who sacrifice for and faithfully serve our country deserve nothing less from the government. For the meantime, let us all be vigilant against black propaganda.
