

WHEREAS, the global problem involving what is now universally known as "climate change" has now affected the Philippines and its Provinces;

WHEREAS, the phenomena of unusual melting of the icebergs, depletion of land mass along the oceans, tsunamis, floodings and global warming that are transpiring around the globe, have been attributed to the so-called "climate change", the Philippines and its provinces, is likewise experiencing unusual erratic climate conditions, lately;

WHEREAS, last year, a destructive typhoon "Sendong" had suddenly found its way to Cagayan de Oro City, Iligan and its neighbor province. An unusual occurrence because the said areas are not in the usual route of typhoons;

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2012, a super typhoon name "Pablo" found its way to the Provinces of Bukidnon and Davao del Sur, a very unusual climatic occurrence, because that was the first time in the history of said province, that a typhoon, super typhoon at that, suddenly found a path that was hitherto unknown to typhoons;

WHEREAS, Bukidnon alone is a well enclaved province against typhoons because of its mountainous terrains, but super typhoon "Pablo" had defied science, and instead, transformed the belief that landlocked areas like Bukidnon are typhoon-free, into a myth;

WHEREAS, the foregoing merely proved that indeed something unusual is happening to mother earth, and that indeed, everybody should do his share to reverse the situation;

WHEREAS, the problems associated with climate change would entail a massive education campaign about environment and how to conserve and protect it. Just as science and math are taught early in schools, so must be subject of environment, be taught now in the elementary and high schools, and make it as a regular curriculum subject;



NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Nemesio B. Beltran, Jr., and with the unanimous accord of the Members present, assembled in session, be it:
