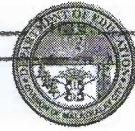

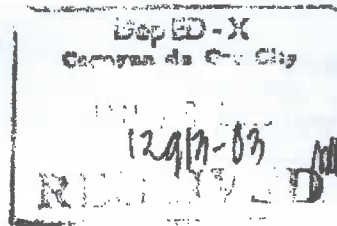

We are pleased to inform you that the Asian Institute of Journalism and Communication (AIJC) will be launching Masters at the Grassroots Program in April, 2013 in Cagayan de Oro City. The program is a series of seminar-workshops on various aspects of communication.

The "MA at the Grassroots Program" is a special program wherein participants will earn academic units leading towards a Masters degree in Journalism or Communication. The program will be hosted by Pilgrim Christian College.

The seminar-workshops will be conducted by some of the country's experts in the field of communication like Dr. Florangel Braid, Dr. Crispin C. Maslog among others. The program will be conducted in time blocks of 8 lecture hours daily for one week per subject.

The first subject Craft of Communication will open the series of seminar-workshops on April 22-27 2013. This will be handled by Dr. Maslog. Aside from earning 3 academic units leading towards a Masters degree, the participants will also get a certificate of completion per subject enrolled.
