IMPLEMENTING THE 2013 BRIGADA ESKWELA

This Division

- Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 40, s. 2013 the Department of Education shall implement the Brigada Eskwela 2013 also known as the National Schools Maintenance Week on May 20-25, 2013. This activity is a school maintenance program that engages all education stakeholders to contribute their time, effort, and resources in ensuring that public facilities are set in time for the forthcoming school opening.
- To go with the DepEd Central Office launching plan this year (to hold a caravan), the Malaybalay City division launching will be done on May 17, 2013 (Friday). This Division-wide activity will begin at 6:00 in the morning with the route of the caravan:

- All Public Schools District Supervisors, secondary school Brigada Eskwela coordinators, participating partners and organizations shall coordinate with the Division Adopt-A-School Program Coordinator **Mr. LUIS S. ALAJAR, Jr.** – EPS Designate in TLE for proper guidance.
- All DepEd employees are encouraged to join the Brigada Eskwela activities by offering their skills or providing their support in kind to public schools near their residence. Interested employees are given two days to do voluntary work **on official time**, provided their work is approved by their respective heads of offices.
- Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- The deadline for submission of the Brigada Eskwela 2013 Accomplishment Report to the Division ASP Coordinator will be on or before **June 28, 2013**.
