1. Pursuant to Unnumbered Regional Memorandum dated May 8, 2013 re: *Regional Integrated Competition*, this Office will conduct a Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents for public and private schools with the theme "*Angkin Talino...Kindergarten Payabungin Mo*" on September 20, 2013 at Casisang Central School, Casisang, Malaybalay City.
2. The competition aims to:
 - a. provide opportunities for the kindergarten pupils to show their knowledge of English and Filipino languages;
 - b. showcase the potentials of the kindergarten pupils in strengthening their confidence and self-esteem;
 - c. enhance the physical, social, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual development of young children; and
 - d. maintain the wholesome environment between public and private schools

3. The contest categories are as follows: (see attached guidelines and mechanics)

1. Vocal Solo	1	1
2. Creative Dance (Focus on Sports Skills)	1 group (10-12 members)	1 group (10-12 members)
3. Nursery Rhyme Recitation	1	1
4. Drawing	1	1

4. Each district should be represented by Public and Private Schools. A registration of One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00) shall be charged per pupil participant and coach to defray expenses for medals, trophies, certificates, meal and snacks of judges/facilitators and other incidental expenses.
5. Registration and travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged against local/school/PTA funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. General guidelines as discussed and committees/judges as agreed, during the meeting of Kindergarten Key Administrators last August 23, 2013 for the conduct of DKFT are enclosed for guidance and information.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

**General Guidelines for the Conduct of the Division Kindergarten
Festival of Talents for Public and Private Schools**

Theme: " Angkin Talino..... Kindergarten Payabungin Mo"

1. Each district both in public and private schools shall conduct their own competitions to select the best contestants in all categories.
2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled Kindergarten pupils in public and private schools aged 5 and about to be 6 years old on October 2013.
3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
4. Only the district champions in public and private schools per category are qualified to join the contest.
5. Coach in each category is required to submit a certified true copy of contestant's birth certificate, 2x2 ID pictures, certification from the principal that the child is currently enrolled in the school and parents permit to join the contest.
6. The number of each contestant in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.
7. There will be a common contest piece for one theme for drawing while the contestants in vocal solo, and nursery rhyme recitation are given the freedom to choose their own piece.
8. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
9. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges. All winners in private and public schools will be determined thru point system.

Rank/Category	Individual	Group
First	15	30
Second	10	20
Third	5	10

Total points garnered in each group (public and private) shall be consolidated to get the over-all champion.

10. All winners will receive medals 1st gold, 2nd silver and 3rd bronze while the over-all champions will receive trophies.
11. The panel of judges shall be composed of a chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.

A. VOCAL SOLO COMPETITION

1. Each contestant is free to choose any song appropriate to children in English or Filipino.
2. Performance time is 3 to 5 minutes including entrance and exit.
3. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used as accompaniment; however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.

a. Voice Quality & Projection	-	25%
b. Rhythm	-	25%
c. Dynamics	-	20%
d. Mastery	-	20%
e. Showmanship	-	<u>10%</u>

B. CREATIVE DANCE COMPETITION

1. The group is composed of at least five (5) pairs, 5 males & 5 females but should not exceed 12 members.
2. Each participating group will create a dance depicting a certain sports of their choice. Example, if they choose basketball, their steps should include dribbling, shooting, throwing and catching.
3. Time of performance should not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

a. Creativity	-	25%
b. Choreography	-	20%
c. Grace & Footwork	-	25%
d. Mastery & Coordination	-	25%
e. Attire	-	<u>5%</u>
TOTAL		100%

C. NURSERY RHYME RECITATION

1. Each contestant will recite a nursery rhyme of his/her choice in English within two (2) minutes including entrance and exit.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

a. Voice clarity & Projection	-	25%
b. Diction	-	20%
c. Interpretation	-	25%
d. Mastery	-	25%
e. Costume	-	<u>5%</u>
TOTAL		100%

D. DRAWING

1. Each contestant will draw on 1 sheet of oslo paper using single crayons in eight (8) colors . Only crayons will be used, no pencil.
2. Contestants will bring their own materials for the contest.
3. The drawing should depict the theme – Ako at ang Aking Kapaligiran.
