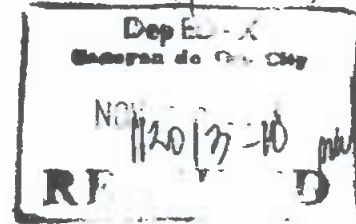

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

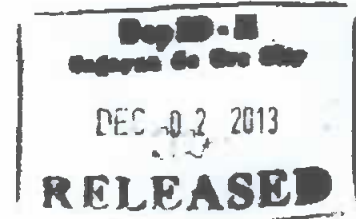

1st Career and Employment Research Congress

Theme: "Nurturing Competencies of Career and Employment Counselors and Advocates through Research"

CALL FOR PAPERS

The call for papers is governed by the following guidelines and procedures.

All educational institutions and agencies, whether public or private are eligible to submit research outputs relevant to the theme "Nurturing Competencies of Career and Employment Counselors and Advocates through Research". Papers may be presented in oral or poster form or both. Please indicate whether it is for Oral or for Poster presentation or both.

Oral Presentation Guidelines

1. Authors are requested to submit electronically a 300-word abstract and a full paper of 15-20 (with references) to the "Career Guidance Network 10" with email addresses acejuly27@yahoo.com or cgn10@yahoo.com on or before December 9, 2013.
2. The paper must be single-spaced using Arial type font (12 pts), formattable copy (preferably in Word File format) and submitted as attachment to email.
3. The presentation must include the title at the top followed by a brief background or introduction, objectives or problems, methodology, summary of findings, conclusions, recommendations, and bibliography.
4. All research presentations shall be allotted 20 minutes for delivery in powerpoint and 10 minutes for open forum.
5. The three best presenters shall be awarded certificates of recognition.

Call For Posters

Researches submitted for poster presentation must meet the following guidelines:

1. Outputs must be printed in a 4 ft. (L) x 3 ft. (H) tarpaulin. The presentation must include the title at the top followed by a brief background or introduction, objectives or problems, methodology, summary of findings, conclusions, recommendations, and bibliography.
2. Graphs and tables may be included but shall not occupy more than 1/3 of the total space presentation.
3. Font size and type shall be left to the discretion of the researcher.
4. Materials for the creation of the poster shall be borne by the presenter.
5. The three best posters shall be awarded certificates of recognition.

Please be informed that accepted manuscript will be further edited and that the Research Congress organizer reserves the right to publish the paper in the peer-reviewed Career and Employment Journal.

All research papers submitted must be properly documented. Researchers must acknowledge the sources they have used in their paper by citing references in the main text and in the bibliography at the end of the paper.
