PROCLAMATION NO. 875

DECLARING MONDAY, 6 OCTOBER 2014, AS A REGULAR HOLIDAY
THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, IN OBSERVANCE OF *EIDUL
ADHA* (FEAST OF SACRIFICE)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9849 provides that *Eidul Adha* shall be
celebrated as a regular holiday;

WHEREAS, *Eidul Adha* is one of the two greatest feasts of Islam;

WHEREAS, the date of the festival is based on the declaration made
by Saudi Arabia's highest religious body;

WHEREAS, the National Commission on Muslim Filipinos (NCMF)
recommended that the observance of *Eidul Adha* be on 6 October 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, President of the
Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare
Monday, 6 October 2014, as a regular holiday throughout the country, in
observance of *Eidul Adha* (Feast of Sacrifice).

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the
seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Lord, Two Thousand and Fourteen.
