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

Subject: **CALL FOR COMMITMENT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ESSENTIAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAM (EHCP) FOR THE SCHOOLS CHILDREN and RELATION TO ALL FEEDING PROGRAMS/PROJECTS IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS IN THIS REGION.**

Date: April 8, 2014

1. In compliance with DepEd Order No. 65 s.2009 and this Region, we are reiterating the implementation of the Essential Health Care Program (EHCP) for the school children effective this June 2014
2. In view of this, all schools are advised to submit report to your Schools Division Superintendent on the following:
 - a. Construction of Water and Hand washing Facilities
 - b. Institutionalize the EHCP (daily toothbrushing and daily handwashing) activities in the class program
 - c. Record de-worming activities per class
 - d. Availability of a health corner in classrooms including EHCP supportive environments (e.g. toothbrush holder)
3. Fully aware of the benefits and the evidenced-based, cost-effective intervention of EHCP in pre-schoolers and Grade 1-VI pupils, it is encouraged that the beneficiaries of the feeding program (supplemental Feeding Program from the canteen source, Private Companies/corporations, Busog lusog Talino(BLT) and other sources are to wash their hands using proper handwashing techniques before the start of the feeding and brush their teeth with fluoride toothpaste after feeding.
4. Elementary School Principals and the Health and Nutrition Personnel shall see that this will be fully implemented.
5. The schedule of the Division EHCP Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) shall be announced on 2nd week of June.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of the content of this Memorandum is desired.

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
