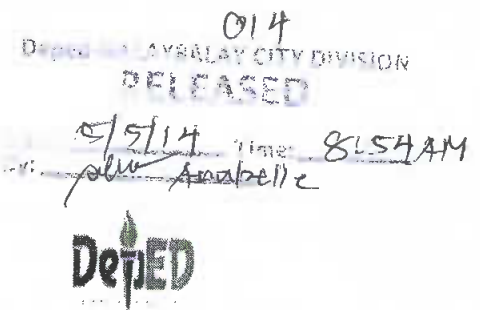

**REGIONAL MASS TRAINING FOR GRADE 9 OF THE K-12 ENHANCED BASIC
EDUCATION PROGRAM**

To: Education Program Supervisors/Coordinators
Secondary School Heads
This Division

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 37, s. 2014, the Regional Office will conduct the Regional Mass Training for Grade 9 Teachers on **May 12-16, 2014 (Batch A)** and **May 19-23, 2014 (Batch B)** at **Bukidnon State University**, Malaybalay City.
2. The training aims to:
 - a. provide teachers with a concrete understanding of the Grade 9 Curriculum Framework, learning standards and competencies, assessment and teaching plan; and
 - b. provide them with opportunity to acquire and demonstrate the values that will guide the teachers in the effective delivery of the curriculum and their role as facilitators of learning.
3. Participants of this Training are all Grade 9 teachers in public secondary schools.
4. The schedule, venue and guidelines of the training are contained in the following enclosures.
 - Enclosure No.1: Schedule, Venue, and Guidelines of the Mass Training for Grade 9 Teachers.
 - Enclosure No. 2: List of Teachers in Grade 9 to participate in the training.

5. Meals and accommodation of all participants shall be charged to the TEI's while travelling and other expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS

1. All participants are advised to register on Day 0, May 11, 2014, **Sunday** (1st Batch) & May 18, 2014, **Sunday** (2nd Batch) at 8:00 a.m. - 12 p.m. at **Bukidnon State University** before they will be given their billeting assignment. First meal will be the dinner on Day 0 of the training while the last meal will be lunch on the last day of the training.
2. The opening program will be on the Day 0, 1:00 p.m. at Bukidnon State University Gymnasium and the closing program will be on the last day of the training between 10:00-11:00 a. m. at their assigned room per learning areas.
3. Participants are advised to check out on the last day of the training.
4. Teachers teaching more than one subject must attend/prefer the subject area where he/she has more loads.
5. Only those officially registered could be accommodated at their respective hotel/dorm. Moreover, those 7-months onward pregnant participants are advised not to join the said training but could be replaced by teacher of the same major/teaching load. Bringing kids during training sessions as well to the hotel/dorm is strictly prohibited.
6. Participants are required to attend the sessions on time wearing proper attire and observe proper decorum throughout the duration of the training. Replacement of participants for valid reasons should be indorsed duly by the school head. Participants are requested to observe the following:

- a. Report to the venues on May 11 for Batch A and on May 18, 2014 for Batch B.
- b. Present their authority to travel and other documents for registration. Substitutes shall only be accommodated if endorsed by Schools Division Superintendent.
- c. The first meal is dinner on Day 0 (May 11 and 18, 2014) and last meal is lunch and afternoon snack on Day 5 (May 16 and 23, 2014).
- d. Participants are advised to check in on Day 0 at 12:00 nn and check out at 12:00 nn on Day 5.
- e. Bring laptop, and always to be fully charged because charging inside the session room is prohibited. However, while the training session is on-going, using of internet is not allowed unless the training demands for it.
- f. Due to budgetary constraints, all participants are advised to bring also art materials (scissor, ruler, pens, cutter, crayons etc.), notebooks and for MAPEH participants, they are requested to bring additional materials like badminton racket, festival costumes whistle and tape measure.
- g. Using cell phone is not prohibited but should be in silent mode during the training session and must be used only for calls and text. Other gadgets like tablets, ipad etc. are strictly prohibited while session is on-going.
- h. In case of brown outs, trainers are advised to prepare for an option B of their presentation.
- i. Attend all sessions on time. Early leavers and those who fail to submit the training outputs shall only receive certificate of appearance.
- j. Come in proper attire and observe proper decorum throughout the duration of the training.
