2014 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC)

**To: Schools Division Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary
All Others Concerned
This Region**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd)-Region X, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, announces the conduct of the **2014 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** with the theme *"Empowering Resilient Communities Through Campus Journalism"* on December 1-3, 2014 in Mambajao, Camiguin, Division of Camiguin.
2. The Conference aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
 - c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
3. The activities of the said conference shall include the following:
 - a. Individual Contests;
 - b. Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting Contests
 - c. Collaborative Publishing Contest
4. Participants are the **Top Three Winners** of the Division Schools Press Conference except for Scriptwriting & Radiobroadcasting and Collaborative Publishing Contest where only the **Top One** per level and category will join the incoming RSPC, coaches/advisers, Division EPS I (English & Filipino), Chief, CLMD, Board of Judges and the Technical Working Group of the Region and Division.
5. Student-Delegates must be certified to be in good health and must have the written permission of his/her parent/guardian which must be collected by the delegation head, per division, and submitted to the RSPC Secretariat upon registration. Each participating school must also submit their school publication to the Registration Committee. Moreover, each delegate is advised to bring along (for blanket) and Off lotion (for mosquitoes).
6. In order to clarify issues and concerns regarding the conduct of the Division Schools Press conferences, concerned officials, officers-in-charge of RSPC, personnel and staff, pupils/staff are advised to refer to the implementing guidelines stipulated in DepEd Order No. 67, s. 2010. The guidelines of the individual and group contests stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 09, s. 2014 (Enclosures 3 to 7) and guidelines on the Search for Outstanding Campus Journalists and School Paper Advisers (Elementary and Secondary) as specified on Reg'l Memo No.115 s. 2012 are still to be followed.
7. Schools which have collected journalism or subscription fees from their students should submit school paper entries and not e-document entries in PDF files.

No Educational Tour.**

The Registration Fee of One Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (P 1,300.00) and other traveling expenses of participants shall be charged against school/local/division/SEF OR School Journalism fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations. This said registration fee is used to defray expenses on board and lodging, kits, materials, trophy, medal and honorarium of the board of judges. Payment in checks shall be addressed to the host division. The first meal (dinner) shall be served on December 1 and the last meal (dinner) on December 3.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

1. Each teacher-participant must pay Sixty Pesos (P60.00), which represents the membership fees in the regional and national school paper advisers association (elementary and secondary). Thirty Pesos (P30.00) of said amount will be retained by the regional association, while Thirty Pesos (P30.00) will be remitted by the RSPAA president to the NSSPAA/PAESPA treasurer during the NSPC.
2. On the other hand, each elementary and secondary student-participant must pay Thirty Pesos (P30.00) which represents the membership fees in the Regional and National Editors Guild. Fifteen Pesos (P15.00) of this amount will be retained by the Regional Editors Guild, while Fifteen Pesos (P15.00) will be remitted to the treasurer of the National Editors Guild during the NSPC.
