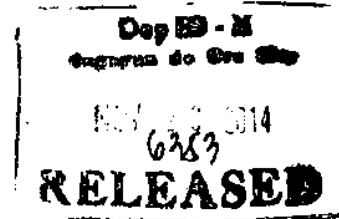

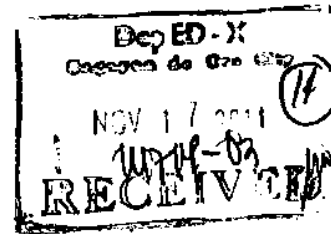

The entire nation is in joyous jubilation for the Apostolic Visit of Pope Francis to the Philippines on January 15-19 2015. This is also a great opportunity to comfort the Filipinos devastated by the typhoon and earthquake that hit the Visayas region last year.

In support to this momentous event, PHLPost in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), has launched the Letter Writing Campaign for the Papal Visit (2015) with the title, "Dear Pope Francis."

This project aims to create awareness about the papal visit to further strengthen the faith of the Filipinos in God and to develop the skills, especially the youth, in composition-writing and their ability to express their thoughts clearly.

The mechanics are as follows:

1. The campaign is open to all Filipinos.
2. Title: "Dear Pope Francis"
3. The composition must be recent, unpublished and original.
4. The composition must be in the form of a letter containing its basic elements (heading, salutation, body of the letter, complimentary close, and signature).
5. All letters must be originally done by the participant.
6. On a separate sheet of paper attached to the composition, the participant must indicate the following information :

*Complete Name and Home Address
Gender of Participant
Age and Date of Birth
Name and Address of School; Grade or Year Level
Contact Number of School and Participant telephone, fax and cell phone numbers)*

7. The deadline for the submission of the letter is on 05 December 2014.
8. All letters to the Pope should be dropped in **SPECIAL DROP BOXES** located in all designated post offices.
9. A Special Committee shall select the best letter and will be presented to the Pope.
