In strengthening the school sports development program, in advocacy and promotion of fitness and wellness program, and in the sustainability of the achievement gained of this Region in the Palarong Pambansa, this Office encourages schools to participate in the 2015 MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS (MLO) Mindanao (18th Edition) on August 21, 2015 and 2015 MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS (MLO) National (7th Edition) on October 23, 2015 at Don Gregorio Pelaez Sports Complex, Velez Street, Cagayan de Oro City per DepED Advisory No. 139, s. 2015 dated May 11, 2015 hereto attached. This participation shall be a potent training ground for athletes aspiring higher avenue in sports in response to Article 1 Sec 2 of Republic Act No. 10588, that "the state shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competition and amateur sports including training for national and international competitions."

The annual interschool sports activity aims to:

- develop athletes' competence in the opted sports discipline;
- recruit athletes from the school level up to higher sports meet;
- inculcate values inherent in sports such as discipline, honesty and sportsmanship; &
- establish camaraderie and teamwork spirit during the games.

This school sports mini Olympic is an interschool junior sports competition where schools from different regions shall compete in the thirteen (13) sports event and two (2) demo sports. Cut off year for student athletes in elementary shall be 2003 while student athletes in the secondary shall be 1998.

PARTICIPATION IN THE 2015 MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS.

Throughout the years, Milo has inspired athletic excellence and active lifestyle for generations of families. As such, Milo now shares its heritage and success in order to build a strong nation of champions and encourage an active and healthy lifestyle among school children.

Knowing the important role that schools play in youth development, Milo brings out the children's athletic excellence through the conduct of the *2015 Milo Little Olympics*, an interschool junior sports competition where schools from different regions, Cagayan de Oro (Region X) on *August 21, 2015*, Sta. Cruz, Laguna (Region IV-A CALARBARZON) on *August 28, 2015*, Baguio City (CAR) on *September 4, 2015*, and Iloilo (Region VI) on *September 11, 2015* compete against each other with a mini-olympic feel displayed by grand opening and closing ceremonies in Cagayan de Oro City on *October 23, 2015* in several events. More than 24,000 young student athletes will compete on this activity.

The program has committed itself to discovering and developing local athletes. It also continues to shape the youth into learning the values of discipline, sportsmanship, and teamwork early in their life.

Participants include elementary pupils from public schools.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*. This activity is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, *An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law)*.
