




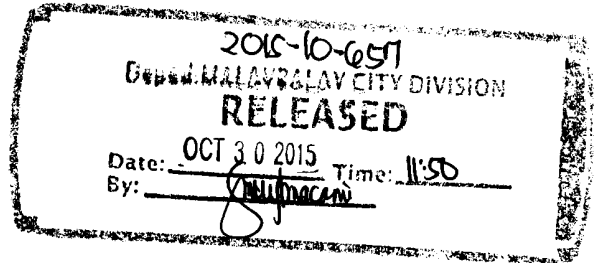

Subject: **DISSEMINATION OF FILARIASIS TRANSMISSION SURVEY**

In collaboration with the DOH Transmission Assessment Survey (TAS) in the Province of Bukidnon, a surveillance activity shall be conducted among randomly identified schools in this Division on November 3- 4 and 9, 2015. This activity will be undertaken to determine sustainability of Lymphatic Filariasis Free Zone declaration in the Province of Bukidnon last 2010. The subjects of the survey are schoolchildren ages 6-7 years old in schools listed herein:

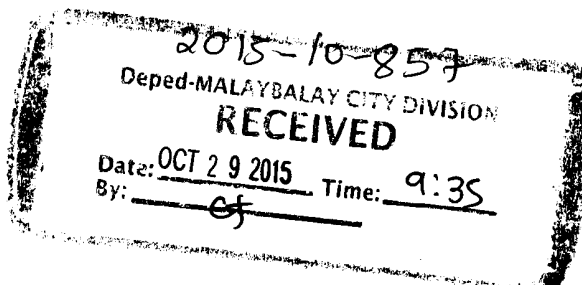

Sir:

This in reference to the scheduled Transmission Assessment Survey (TAS) using Immuno Chromatographic Test (ICT), a necessary surveillance activity that the Province of Bukidnon must undertake this year. The survey will need 3,000 plus children ages 6 – 7 years old as subjects to test whether the province has sustained its status as Lymphatic Filariasis Free Zone since its declaration last June 2010.

The DOH with the RITM, by random sampling, identified schools with its corresponding specific number of students in every city and municipality to comprise the needed 3,000 subjects. During the orientation several months ago, both the Municipal/City Medical Technologists and DepEd Nurses (composition of survey team in every municipality/city) had agreed to partner city/municipal survey team with its neighboring survey team to support each other during the survey.

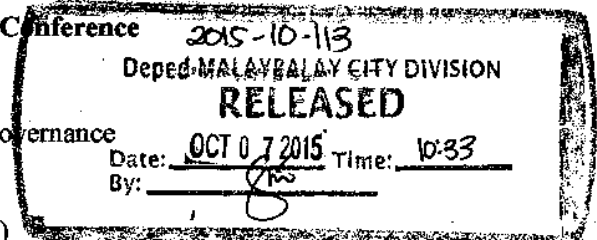

1. Malaybalay City Division announces the conduct of the 2015 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) with the theme *The Role of 21st Century Campus Journalist in Upholding Good Governance Leadership and Transparency* on October 26 -27, 2015 in Casisang Central, Malaybalay City.

2. The conduct of this conference is pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991.


3. The conference aims to:

- a. Demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
- b. Sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
- c. Provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for pupils/ students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
- d. Promote responsible journalism and fair ethical use of social media and;
- e. Enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions

4. The conference activities shall include the following contests for campus editors in English and Filipino both elementary and secondary in public and private schools.

Feature Writing (*Pagsulat ng Lathalain*) 4. Editorial Writing (*Pagsulat ng Editoryal*) 5. Science & Health Writing (*Pagsulat ng Agham at Pangkalusugan*) 6. News Writing (*Pagsulat ng Balita*) 7. Editorial Cartooning (*Kartung Pang-editoryal*) 8. Sports Writing (*Pagsulat ng Isports*)
- b. **Group Contests** (Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting and Collaborative Publishing Contest)

5. Participants to this conference are the top three (3) winners in the 2015 District Schools Press Conference from both public and private categories.
6. A registration Fee of One hundred pesos (P 100.00) will be charged to each Private school participant to supplement payment for trophies, medals, certificates, other supplies, honoraria, meals and snacks of judges, facilitators during the activity.
7. Travelling expenses and meals are chargeable against local /school funds subject to the usual accounting, policies, rules and regulations.
