I. Proposal

To hold (a) five (5) days training workshops for MAPEH/P.E. Arnis teachers and coaches by the professional staff of **Puñada Martial Arts International (PMAI)**-an Arnis and Self-defense organization.

II. Rationale

Arnis is touted as a martial arts quintessentially Filipino, and has become part of the Physical Education curriculum in our primary and secondary schools. With the approval of Congress (2007-10). "Republic Act No. 9850: An Act declaring Arnis as the national martial art and sport of the Philippines." Metro Manila: 14th Congress of the Philippines, Third regular session, 2009.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Republic Act No. 9850, approved on 11 December 2009, defines the indigenous Filipino martial art of Arnis and declares it as the "Philippine National Martial Art and Sport." The Act then orders the Department of Education, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, and the Philippine Sports Commission to promulgate the rules and regulations necessary to carry out its provisions., this Pinoy sports made its debut in the SEA Games in Manila, Philippines 2005.

Unfortunately, though taught in school and already our national sports, Arnis begs professionalism in its teaching and development, and promotion as a martial arts significantly Pinoy. It has yet to be deeply ingrained in our culture like jujitsu to the Japanese, Taekwondo to the Koreans and Kung Fu to the Chinese. Arnis as Pinoy sports and martial arts needs a highly professional outfit to supplement the infrastructures and personnel of the Department of Education, competent and able hands to groom Dep-Ed's P.E. teachers to teach and promote the sports, in continuous year-round strings of training workshops and regional and national tournaments. Not only to raise Arnis-disciplined champs for the SEA Games, but sturdy, healthy, law-abiding citizens quick on their reflexes, sharp on their minds.

An Arnis organization of professional competence in the martial arts and extensive experience in handling training workshops and tournaments like **Puñada Martial Arts International (PMAI), Inc.** fits this need to a tee.

III. Objectives

1. To equip all MAPEH/P.E. Arnis teachers on the fundamentals of Arnis as a martial arts.
2. To lay the groundwork for the development and promotion of Arnis as a national sport through the DepEd division and regional competitions.
3. To foster professionalism in the teaching of Arnis by making accessible supplies like books and Arnis sticks as well as training workshops and periodic tournaments.
4. To equip teaches and students in basic Puñada self defense.

IV. Profile of Puñada Martial Arts International (PMAI), Inc.

Puñada Martial Arts International started in 1992 and was incorporated and registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission in 2007. But as far back as 2002, PMAI has already become a member of Arnis Philippines, (NSA, Member POC & PSC) where PMAI Founder and Director Ernesto "Nestee" M. Luis, Jr. has been a commissioner for 5 consecutive years, Arnis Officiating Official during SEA Games 2005.


The school has a population of more than 30,000 students, including members of the U.S. Joint Special Operations Task Force-Philippines, under the "*Balikatan Exercises*," like the Army Special Forces and Navy Seals. Since its inception, the school has been conducting martial arts tournaments and has successfully participated in Arnis Philippines (NSA) national competitions. The outfit has also conducted training workshops even outside Zamboanga City, (Region 7 and Region 9).

V. Requirements for Participants

1. Participants must be young MAPEH/P.E. teachers, Arnis coach or aficionados of the sports in elementary and secondary both public and private schools.
2. Participants must each pay a registration fee of P 2,000.00 for the five-days training workshop to cover Arnis sticks with cases, T-Shirts, and reading materials.
3. Participants must be in Sports attire during the training.

I may submit if require our Memorandum of Agreement with your organization, renewable every three years, to ensure an uninterrupted implementation of this continuous program for the training, Officiating, development and promotion of Arnis as national sports and martial arts. May you find this proposal comprehensive and favorable. God blesses us all.
