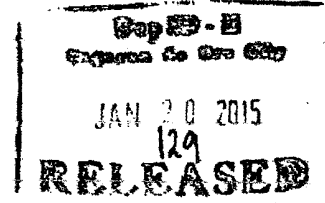

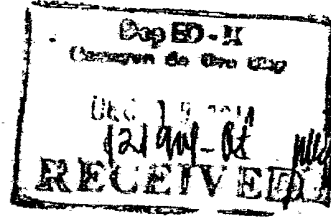

The Regional Elementary Science Supervisors are expected to attend; Division Science Supervisors, Science Enthusiasts and Science Teachers are invited to attend but they have to take charge of their own board and lodging.

The registration fee of P 3,100.00 which accounts for the accommodation from Day 0 to Day 3 and meals from dinner of Day 0, January 31 to Lunch of Day 3, February 3 of the contestants and coaches. Non-participants and observers who wish to join in the science congress will be charged each for their meals and accommodation.

Improvised science equipment and science instructional aid should be limited to 12 x 16 x 12 inches in size. Finished equipment and instructional aid should be the first and second place winners in the region.
