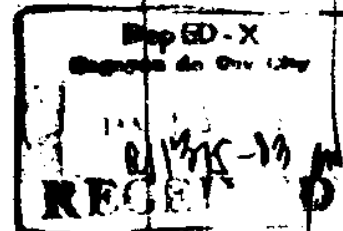

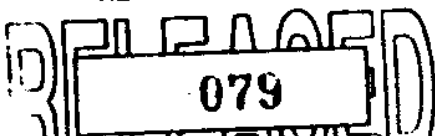

WHEREAS, on 03 October 2013, Republic Act No. 10632 was enacted entitled "AN ACT TO POSTPONE THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN ELECTIONS ON OCTOBER 28, 2013, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9340, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES;"

WHEREAS, Section 1 of the said law provided for the postponement of the scheduled sangguniang kabataan elections to a date to be determined by the Commission between 28 October 2014 and 23 February 2015, to wit:

"SECTION 1 Date of Election. - There shall be a synchronized barangay and sangguniang kabataan elections which shall be held on July 15, 2002. Subsequent synchronized elections and sangguniang kabataan elections shall be held on the last Monday of October 2007 and every three (3) years thereafter; Provided, That the sangguniang kabataan elections on October 28, 2013 shall be postponed to a date to be determined by the COMELEC between October 28, 2014 and February 23, 2015"

WHEREAS, on 08 October 2013, the Commission issued Resolution No. 9791 entitled "IN THE MATTER OF THE INITIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10632 POSTPONING THE OCTOBER 28, 2013 SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) ELECTIONS;"

WHEREAS, in the said Resolution, the Commission ordered to (1) POSTPONE and RESET the conduct of the Sangguniang Kabataan Elections to another date between 28 October 2014 and 23 February 2015, (2) DISCONTINUE all preparations, (3) RENDER ineffective and without force all Resolutions and (4) DIRECT all officials and deputies to preserve and maintain all documents, forms and supplies pertaining to the said elections;

WHEREAS, due to the impending deadline to hold the Special Sangguniang Kabataan Elections, the Commission deemed it imperative to set the date of its conduct on 21 February 2015 and

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WHEREAS, in the said *Resolution*, the Commission ordered to (1) **POSTPONE** and **RESET** the conduct of the Sangguniang Kabataan Elections to another date between 28 October 2014 and 23 February 2015, (2) **DISCONTINUE** all preparations, (3) **RENDER** ineffective and without force all Resolutions and (4) **DIRECT** all officials and deputies to preserve and maintain all documents, forms and supplies pertaining to the said elections;

WHEREAS, due to the impending deadline to hold the Special Sangguniang Kabataan Elections, the Commission deemed it imperative to set the date of its conduct on 21 February 2015 and

initiate preparatory activities, including among others, the conduct of voter registration activities;

WHEREAS, various resolutions promulgated prior to the postponement of the Sangguniang Kabataan Elections which were deemed ineffective and rendered without force and effect, may be adopted for reimplementation for the conduct of the 21 February 2015 Special Sangguniang Kabataan Elections, subject to certain modifications.

NOW THEREFORE, after due deliberation, the Commission *In Banc*, by virtue of the powers vested in it by the Constitution, the Omnibus Election Code, the Local Government Code, and Republic Acts Nos. 6653, 6679, 8524, 9164, and 9340, hereby **RESOLVES** to **PRESCRIBE** the following calendar of activities and periods of prohibited acts in connection with the Special Sangguniang Kabataan Elections:
