4. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum and compliance is desired.

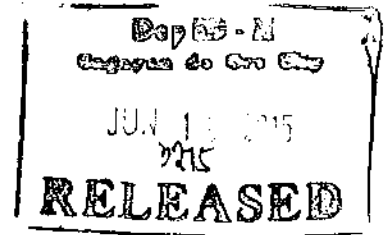

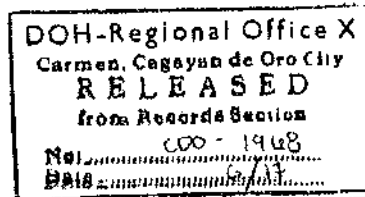

Warm greetings!

The Department of Health Regional Office X appreciates the full participation of the Department of Education Region X Division Superintendents, Supervisors, Medical Officers, Nurses-in Charge and the Regional Health and Nutrition Unit lead by Dr. Rosalina Edullantes in the Orientation on Integrated Helminthiasis Control Program (IHCP), other Neglected Tropical Diseases and Non-communicable Diseases programs which involves School Children last June 2 to 5, 2015 in Manoto Fortich, Bukidnon.

Deworming children in schools has been found to be a good strategy to reduce the burden of Soil Transmitted Helminthiasis (STH) infections with a positive impact on children's education and health provided that the desired MDA coverage of at least 85% is achieved. Thus in order to further benefit from the positive effects of deworming, the National School Deworming Day (NSDD) was designed to scale-up efforts in improving health care service delivery for all school-aged children targeting all 5 to 12 years old (Kindergarten to Grade VI) enrolled in public elementary schools.

On the other hand, vaccination has been proven to be the most effective public health intervention. It protects not only the individual but also other members of the family and the community. The Philippines Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) has focused on the provision of free vaccines for infants as their primary immunization series for several years. However, protection provided by some of these vaccines will decline overtime and booster doses must be needed to ensure high levels of protection are maintained. Thus, it is very important that health service providers take the every available opportunity to deliver vaccines and start vaccination for the schoolchildren and adolescents enrolled. With this, there will be a Nationwide School-Based Immunization activity by August 1-30, 2015, particularly for Grade 1 and Grade VII.

In lieu of these activities, in preparation for the National School Deworming Day on July 29, 2015 and the implementation of the school based immunization on August 1-30, 2015, the Department of Health Region X together with the Department of Education and Local Government Units will conduct a **JOINT ONE-DAY ORIENTATION** on School Based Immunization and National School Deworming Day (NSDD). We therefore invite the School Division Superintendents, District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary School Principals, Health and Science Supervisors, School Nurses/ Health and Nutrition Incharge and Federated
