

**DIVISION RETOOLING OF TEACHERS & SCHOOL HEADS SERVING IP COMMUNITIES CUM VALIDATION OF DIVISION IPEd FRAMEWORK**

To: Education Program Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors (Districts 1, 2, 7, 8, & 10)  
School Heads (of schools serving indigenous people)  
This Division

1. Pursuant to DepED Order No. 62, s. 2011 re Adopting the Indigenous Peoples' Education Policy Framework which focuses on the principles of participation, inclusion and empowerment, the Division of Malaybalay City will conduct Phase 2 **Division Retooling of Teachers and School Heads Serving IP Communities cum Validation of IPEd Framework** at Loiza's, Casisang, Malaybalay City on July 1-3, 2015.
2. The activity is conducted to validate for affirmation the IPEd framework crafted for learners in consultation with the "elders" in our IP communities as well as to learn indigenized songs and effective teaching strategies.
3. Participants of the intervention are the following: Tribal leaders from IP Communities who participated in the refinement of the framework; School Heads & school IP coordinators (pregnant teachers are exempted) of Baganao ES, Bangcud CS, *Caburacanan ES, Can-ayan ES, Dahwangan ES, Patpat ES, Kalasungay CS, Kapitan Anghel ES, Kibalabag ES, Kilap-agan ES, Kulaman ES, Linabo CS, Manalog ES, St. Peter ES, Silae ES, Tag-ilanao & Tintinaan ES*; NCIP/ Indigenous Peoples Organization; Division Office Staff/ PSDS (*District 1,2,7,8, & 10*); Facilitators; & Support staff.
4. Meals and materials for the activity and lodging for resource persons will be charged to IPEd Funds while travel expenses will be charged to local/school funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination compliance to this Memorandum is enjoined.
