2015 DRUM AND LYRE CORPS COMPETITION

- 1. The Province of Bukidnon through the Division of Malaybalay City shall conduct the 2015 Drum and Lyre Competition on October 1, 2015 as one of the highlights to open the 2015 KAAMULAN Festival Celebration with the theme: "Kulturang Lokal: Instrumento sa pagpapatuloy sa Pag-unlad ng Lokal na Pamahalaan." (Local Culture: An important tool in sustaining Progress and Development in Local Government).
- 2. The competition aims to:
  - a. support the National thrust in promoting arts and culture of excellence;
  - develop greater opportunity for musical growth through display in playing musical instruments; and
  - c. strengthen camaraderie and unity among secondary schools in the entire province.

## 2015 DRUM & LYRE CORPS COMPETITION GUIDELINES:

- 1. The Competition must be purely Drum and Lyre only. The instrumentation shall consist of a typical marching band (cymbals, snare, tenor and bass drums) with the addition of lyre section. An exhibition of performing drum and lyre corps with their free interpretation of three (3) musical pieces/arrangement of their choice typically pitched in the key of C: one (1) English love song; one (1) Tagalog novelty song; and one (1) Pop song. The performance shall include fancy drill formations/choreography and unorthodox musical arrangements.
- 2. The competition is open to all public and private Secondary School Bands in the entire province of Bukidnon, however, participants are limited to <u>5 slots only on a first come first serve basis</u>.
- 3. Participating groups shall have a minimum of fifty (50) and a maximum of two hundred (200) performers inclusive of musical players/instrumentalist, majorettes, flag bearers or movers and is encouraged to infuse the exhibition of batons and other hand props as the case may be and styles as in cheer dancing. Absolutely no stunts and use of more than two levels of risers during the entire show.
- 4. All performers must be a bonafide (enrolled) students of the school they represent and must submit a certification duly signed by the Principal or School Head.
- 5. Competing groups are given 10 to 15 minutes performance inclusive of entrance and exit. One (1) point will be added to the final Rank of each team/entry for every minute or fraction thereof that will exceed to the time allotted. Official Timers are commissioned by the organizer to do the task.
- 6. Costumes of the participants must be modest and in decent form. Pyrotechnics and other hazardous or dangerous props are strictly prohibited.
- 7. Designated representatives of all participating contingents are required to attend the Final Briefing and drawing of lots to determine the order of presentation on September 30, 2015 a day before the competition on October 1, 2015. Venue: Conference Hall, 3:00 pm at the Division of Malaybalay City, Sayre Highway, Casisang, Malaybalay City.
- 8. A panel of board of judges shall determine the winners. The decision of the panel is final and irrevocable.
