

**DIVISION POPULATION QUIZ (POPQUIZ) AND ON-THE-SPOT CONTESTS
ON POPULATION AND DEVELOPMENT SY 2015-2016**

This Division**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 58, s. 2014, DepED Memorandum No. 363, s. 2010 and DECS Memorandum No. 243, s. 1996 which provided for the institutionalization of Population Quiz nationwide, this Office shall conduct Division Level Population Quiz, On-the-Spot Contests on Population and Development (Poster Making Contest, Essay Writing Contest and Jingle Writing and Singing) to public and private secondary schools/students as well as Laboratory schools of state colleges and universities on **October 13, 2015 (Tuesday) 8:00 A.M at the Bukidnon National High School, Malaybalay City.**
2. As stipulated on DepED Memorandum No. 363, s. 2010, the activity aims to:
 - a. sustain awareness and interest in population issues and matters among in-school youth and the general public;
 - b. convey population and development concepts/messages to students such as responsible parenthood, poverty, adolescent, reproductive health gender, population, environment, resources and sustainable development;
 - c. raise awareness on Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) and Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) among high school students; and
 - d. promote values supportive of population and development education among in-school youth.

3. Only one (1) contestant per school with an official coach per event/contest and must come to the venue in their proper school uniform before 8:00 A.M. on the scheduled date.
4. All participants in the four events/contests are requested to bring their own food provisions (snacks and lunch).
5. The Population Quiz shall focus on the Population Education core messages/key concepts as follows:
 - 5.1 Family Life and Responsible Parenthood
 - 5.2 Gender and Development
 - 5.3 Population and Reproductive Health
 - 5.4 Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development
6. English and Filipino will be used as official languages in the conduct of the quiz.
7. Twenty (20) questions will be given, six (6) of which are "easy" equivalent to one (1) point each; seven (7) are "average" for two (2) points each and seven (7) questions labeled "difficult" equivalent to three (3) points every correct answer. In case of tie, tiebreaker question/s/clinchers from the "difficult" category must be given.
8. Contests Guidelines, rules, mechanics, Board of Judges/Facilitators and management of the population quiz and on-the-spot contests are contained in the enclosure.
9. First place winners per event/contest category shall represent the division at the regional level contests.

A. On-The-Spot Poster Making Contest (8:30 A.M.)

1. One (1) participant per school is required to bring the prescribed materials: ½ illustration board and oil pastel. No other art materials should be used aside from those prescribed.
2. The specific theme of the contest will be announced a few minutes before the start of the contest.
3. For the entry, there should be no markings on the surface of the artwork. Name and the name of the school should be printed at the back of the artwork.
4. An identification number will be issued to the participant. This should be placed on the right upper part of the artwork.
5. Participants will be given two (2) hours to finish their entry.
6. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

Criteria for Judging:

a. Creativity/Presentation	-	50%
b. Relevance to the theme	-	20%
c. Originality	-	30%

B. On-The-Spot Jingle Writing and Singing Contest (English, 8:30 A.M.)

1. Participants shall be provided with sheets of paper.
2. The specific theme, mechanics and the criteria for judging the contest will be announced a few minutes before the start of the contest.
3. For the entry, there should be no markings on the surface of the paper. Name and the name of the school should be printed at the back of the contest piece.
4. Participants will be given one (1) hour to finish their entry. After which, the contest piece shall be performed in Acapella (without instrument) in front of the board of judges and the audience.
5. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

Criteria for Judging:

a. Musicality	-	30%
b. Lyrics (Body of the verse use in the musical composition, relevance to the theme)	-	50%
c. Originality	-	20%

Date: August 6, 2014

1. In consonance with DECS Memo. No. 243 s. 1996 which provided for the institutionalization of Population Quiz nationwide, this region enjoins the schools and divisions to conduct Population Quiz and On-the-Spot Contests on Population and Development (Poster-Making Contest, Essay Writing Contest and Jingle Writing and Singing Contest)
2. As stipulated on DepEd Memorandum No. 363, s. 2010, the activity aims to:
 - a. sustain awareness and interest in population issues and matters among in-school youth and the general public;
 - b. convey population and development concepts/messages to students such as responsible parenthood, poverty, adolescent reproductive health, gender, population, environment, resources and sustainable development;
 - c. raise awareness on Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) and Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) among high school students in the Philippines; and
 - d. promote values supportive of population and development education among in-school youth.
3. The contests shall be conducted according to the following timetable:

School Level	- August

Regional Level	- October 18, 2014

4. The Regional Population Quiz and On-the-Spot Contests shall be held on October 18, 2014, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The venue shall be announced on a corrigendum.
5. Each division shall be represented by the first place winners in their division level contests. The regional winners shall represent the region at the national level contests.
6. The participants, mechanics and management of the contests at various levels are contained in the enclosure pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 205, s. 2012 entitled 2013 National Festival of Talents.
7. Traveling and other related expenses including board and lodging of the Division POPEd Coordinators, contestants and coaches shall be charged to local/school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Division POPEd Coordinators shall send the names of the contestants to the Secondary Education Division (SED), Attn: The POPEd Regional Coordinator at telefax no.: 088-856-2793 not later than October 11, 2014.
