**DIVISION TRAINING WORKSHOP ON CONTEXTUALIZING
THE CURRICULUM FOR GRADE TWO**

To: Education Program Supervisors, CID & SGOD Chiefs and Staff

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 62, s. 2011 and DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2015 on *Indigenous Peoples' Education Policy & Curriculum Framework*, the *Division of Malaybalay City* will conduct a **Division Training Workshop on Contextualizing the Curriculum for Grade Two** at Loiza's, Casisang, Malaybalay City on November 26-28, 2015.
2. At the end of the training workshop, participants are expected to develop a holistic perspective on the overall learning and socio-cultural context of indigenous communities. In particular, participants are expected to:
 - a. walk through the competencies towards the contextualization of the curriculum responsive to indigenous community being served;
 - b. develop lesson plans based on the contextualized curriculum for IP education; and
 - c. produce school based lesson plans reflecting a culture-responsive and culture-sensitive education for the Indigenous learners.
3. Resource persons on the language and the IKSPs are the IP elders considered as culture bearers of the Bukidnon and Higaonon tribes.
4. Facilitators of the activity are school heads and teachers who attended the Regional TOT, namely: Dr. Manny Pimentel, Narita Padua, Teofilo Ontoy, Amor Rojas, Sonny Rojas, Mary Fe Gumayao, Dr. Jesus Muring, and Raquel Ombayan.
3. Participants of the training workshop are the select *school heads and select grade two and grade one teachers who speak Binukid/Higaonon language* from schools serving IP communities, NCIP, Division Office TWG, & Support Staff.
