2. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is highly enjoined.

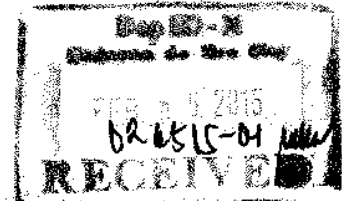


