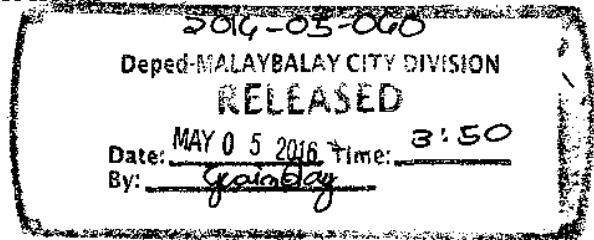

- Has not been found guilty of crime or offense involving moral turpitude.
