The Nagkahiusang Magsusulat sa Cagayan de Oro (NAGMAC), a local literary community of new-wave poets, fictionists, essayists, and playwrights, in partnership with the Xavier University Department of English, a CHED Center of Development in Literature, proudly present the 2016 Creative Writing Summer Classes for Students and Teachers on May 14, 21, 28 and June 04 at the English Department Reading Room, SS 201, 2nd Floor Social Science Building, Xavier University-Ateneo de Cagayan.

Aiming to revitalize Northern Mindanao's local literary scene and assert our identity in the map of regional literatures in the country, NAGMAC has organized regular spoken word events—dubbed as CDO Poetry Night—and recently, the 1st Cagayan de Oro Writers Workshop. Future activities also include partnerships with academes, corporate entities, and government units. The 2016 Creative Writing Summer Classes is a four-part lecture-writeshop series on the four literary genres: Poetry, Fiction, Creative Non-Fiction, and Drama. Added is a special session on Literatures in the Binisaya language from Visayas and Mindanao. Target audience for such lectures are teachers and students of literature and creative writing and literature enthusiasts in general.

NAGMAC's resident mentors will serve as resource persons: multi-published poet Arlene J Yandug, Palanca awardee fictionist-essayist Ma Elena L Paulma, multilingual dramaturg-critic Rogelio F Garcia, Jr, and regional literature luminary Raul G Moldez. Slots are limited to 25 seats only. Registration fees (per session) are Php 100 for students and Php 150 for professionals, inclusive of a certificate. Program runs from 1 until 5 PM.
