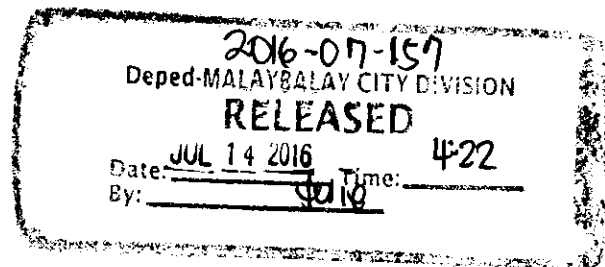

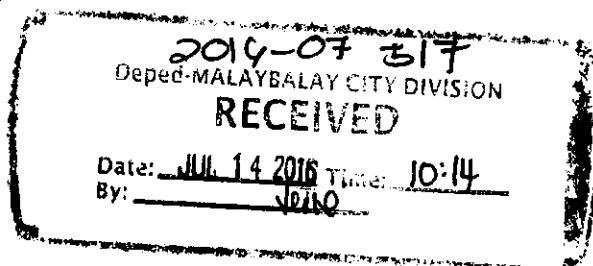

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-027R(12TH SP)
(23rd Regular Session)

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SPORTS ACHIEVEMENT
REWARDS SYSTEM FOR ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL
PUPILS FROM THE PROVINCE OF BUKIDNON WHO WIN MEDALS
IN REGIONAL AND NATIONAL SPORTS COMPETITIONS AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR --**

WHEREAS, athletes from the province of Bukidnon have competed and won medals in regional and national sports competitions thereby bringing pride and honor to the province despite the lack of funds for their adequate training, quality equipment and other needs;

WHEREAS, to sustain the accomplishments of Bukidnon athletes in regional and national competitions, if not bring it to new heights, there is a need for the province to implement a sustainable sports achievement incentive system that will inspire and encourage the athletes in the grassroots level and support them as they grow and compete in the regional and national level as elite athletes;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Jay S. Albarece, and with the unanimous accord of the Members present, assembled in session:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Province of Bukidnon, this 28th day of June, in the Year of Our Lord, Two Thousand and Sixteen, that:

SECTION 1. Elementary Pupil and Secondary Students from the province of Bukidnon who garner medals in reputable national and regional sports competitions shall be given cash incentives in the following amounts:

- I. Regional Level:
 - A. Individual Competition
 - a) Gold Medal/First Place - P2,000.00
 - b) Silver Medal/Second Place - P1,500.00
 - c) Bronze Medal/Third Place - P1,000.00
 - B. Team Competition
 - a) Gold Medal/First Place - P4,000.00
 - b) Silver Medal/Second Place - P3,000.00
 - c) Bronze Medal/Third Place - P2,000.00
- II. National Level:
 - A. Individual Competition
 - a) Gold Medal/First Place - P4,000.00
 - b) Silver Medal/Second Place - P3,000.00
 - c) Bronze Medal/Third Place - P2,000.00
 - B. Team Competition
 - a) Gold Medal/First Place - P5,000.00
 - b) Silver Medal/Second Place - P4,000.00
 - c) Bronze Medal/Third Place - P3,000.00

SECTION 2. For purposes of this ordinance, the regional or national competition must be organized or sanctioned by any of the following:

- a) The Northern Mindanao Regional Athletic Association (NMRAA);
- b) The Private Schools Regional Athletic Association of Region 10 (PRISAA 10)
- c) The Department of Education
- d) The Department of Interior and Local Government
- e) The Philippine Sports Association
- f) The Philippine Olympic Committee
- g) Any national sports association recognized by the Philippine Olympic Committee (ABAP, PFF, PABA, BAP, Samahang Basketbol ng Pilipinas (SBP), e.g.)

SECTION 3. A regional competition is one with participants from other provinces in Region X, including a Mindanao-wide competition, while a national competition is one which has participants from all over the country and specifically designated as a "national" games, tournament, championship, challenge or finals, including national age-group and collegiate finals and championships.

Regional or national try-outs, fun games or other non-top level or top category competitions are excluded from the definition of regional or national level competitions for purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. A regional competition is one with participants from other provinces in Region X, while a national competition is one which has participants from all over the country and specifically designated as a "national" games, tournament, championship, challenge or finals, including national age-group and collegiate finals and championships.

Regional or national eliminations, qualifying, try-outs, fun games or other non-top category competitions are excluded from the definition of regional or national level competitions for purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Winning athletes and coaches may claim their financial incentive in Section 1 above within one (1) year from the conduct of regional or national competition, otherwise the same is deemed waived, by presenting to the Office of the Governor the following:

- a) Any credible proof of the claimant is an athlete who has won in the regional or national competition or an officially registered coach of the winning athlete during the competition.
- b) Proof of residence in the province of Bukidnon.


SECTION 6. For the implementation of this ordinance, an initial amount of TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P200,000.00) from the General Fund is hereby appropriated for the purpose. Thereafter, the necessary amount shall be included in the annual budget and appropriation ordinance.

SECTION 7. Copies of this Ordinance shall be distributed to the DEP-ED Superintendents and Supervisors, the Municipal Mayors, the Provincial and Municipal Sports Coordinators in the province of Bukidnon for their information and guidance.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
