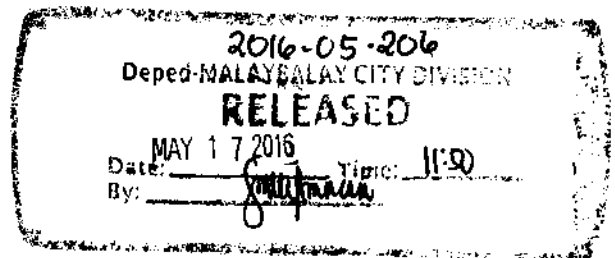

- Equip Grade 11 Senior High School Teachers the competencies needed as they deliver the interplay of curriculum instruction and assessment as learner-centered SHS Grade 11 Teachers;
- Express commitment in the attainment of training, &
- Appreciate the system of the Department of Education.

4 Teacher participants and facilitators/content experts are advised to bring their own kitchen paraphernalia (plate, mug, spoon and fork), extension wire, laptop/netbook or android phone and pocket wifi (optional) for online evaluation. Participants are further advised to go directly to MOGCHS for registration at 8:00 o'clock in the morning and shall check in on the assigned billeting quarter on Day 1 and shall check out on the last day of the training before 12:00 o'clock noon. Billeting quarters shall be announced later in a separate Memorandum. First meal shall be Breakfast on Day 1 and will be served at MOGCHS, while last meal shall be lunch on the last day of the training. Opening Program shall be at 10:00 o'clock in the morning to be followed by the training proper at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon.

5 Schools Division Offices are requested to provide 1 LCD unit except for big Divisions (Bukidnon, Misamis Occidental, Cagayan de Oro, Iligan) who will provide 2 units; while, the host Division (Misamis Oriental) will provide 5 units to be used for the entire duration which shall be handled by your respective facilitators/content experts (Academic/TVL) involved in this training.

6 Teacher-participants and trainers shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepED Order 53, s. 2003: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credit to Teachers. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel including the management staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.

7 Traveling expenses of teacher-participants shall be charged to local funds while Food, accommodation and traveling expenses of trainers, facilitators, and management & support staff shall be charged against downloaded HRTD Funds from Central Office subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
