

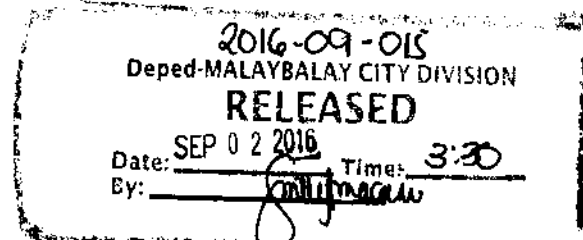

1. Pursuant to the conduct of **2016 National Festival of Talents (NFOT)**, this Office through **Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD)** shall hold the **5th Regional Festival of Talents in Technolympics** on **October 26-28, 2016** at **Opol National Secondary Technical School, Opol, Misamis Oriental**.
2. The Festival of Talents in Technolympics aims to:
 - provide opportunities to showcase their talents in **Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE)** and **Technical Vocational Education (TVE)**;
 - showcase various products and performance as evidence of the students learning; and
 - extend parallel learning sessions for teachers and students to enhance their knowledge and skills in their respective field of interest.
3. Participants to this activity are the first place winners during the Division level Technolympics competition.
4. A registration fee of **One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00)** will be charged to each participant for expenses incurred such as meals and snacks, prizes, supplies and materials, honorarium of judges, contest consumable materials, transportation and other supplemental expenses during the activity and shall be charged against regional/division/local/school funds

subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. First meal shall be dinner on Day 0 (October 26, 2016) and last meal shall be lunch on Day 2 (October 28, 2016).

5. The schedule and event packages for the Technolympics are contained in the enclosures.

6. Student participants are required to bring their beddings. Early payment of registration is encouraged to all participating divisions and shall submit list of participants via email onsts_08, Attention MR. ANTHONY Y. PACAMALAN, ONSTS Principal II . The said school shall be responsible on the fiscal management of the activity.

8. Teacher-coach who attended the NFOT in Technolympics will serve as the contest administrator during the Regional Technolympics Competition.

Note: Principals, Schools Heads who wish to attend the competition shall inform in advance the Principal of Opol National Secondary Technical School for accommodation but will register.

The following special materials and equipment are required to be brought by the participants

A. Industrial Arts

1. Automotive Servicing - Bring functional Toyota 4k Mack-up Engine and the materials needed in servicing based on the Curriculum Guide for Grades 9 and 10 and Personal Protective Equipment.
2. Consumer Electronic Servicing - Bring functional Electric Fan, Flat Iron, Rice Cooker, Blender and the materials and equipment needed in servicing based on the Curriculum Guide for Grades 9 and 10.
3. Electrical Installation and Maintenance - Bring all electrical fixtures and materials and equipment needed for electrical installation based on the Curriculum Guide for Grade 9 and 10 and Personal Protective Equipment. Wire #12 and #14 will be provided.

B. Home Economics

1. Nail Art with Hand Massage - Bring all contest materials and equipment

2. Children's Wear Construction (Casual for Girls 5-6 years old) - Bring functional motorized sewing machine and sewing tools. Cloth, Thread, Zipper and Buttons will be provided.
3. Hair Style and Facial Make-Up - Bring all contest materials and equipment

C. Agri/Fishery Arts

1. Experimental Fish Dish - Bring cooking gear, tools and equipment. Fish will be provided.
2. Experimental Cookery from dressing to plating - Bring cooking gear tools and equipment Live chicken will be provided.
3. Landscaping - Bring tools and equipment including 3 rare plants and silhouette stones and Personal Protective Equipment other contest materials will be provided.

D. Information and Communication Technology

1. Web Page Designing – Bring USB for printing
2. Tarpaulin Designing - Bring USB for printing
3. PC Assembly with configuration and Networking - Bring own PC unit

E. Bazaar Exhibit

- a. All participating regions are required to display their best products and services before the opening program. However the division will choose only one entry for each product and service to participate in the search for the most enterprising award. Each division shall assign two TLE/TVE students who are not participating in the skills exhibition to market their products/services within the exhibit booth area.
- b. All products/services displayed in the bazaar which are produced or rendered by the TLE or TVE students as certified by the school head can be offered for sale. No items other than those mentioned earlier shall be displayed in the bazaar.
- c. The points earned in the bazaar Exhibit shall be included in the computation of the overall results.

The criteria for judging the Bazaar Exhibits – the Most Enterprising Award shall be based on the following:

Originality and design _____	15%
Visual Appeal/impact _____	15%
• Marketability of the product/service _____	30%
(Appropriate pricing and taste _____)	30%
• Communication Skills and Knowledge of the product/service _____	30%
• Gross sale of the product/service _____	10%
