

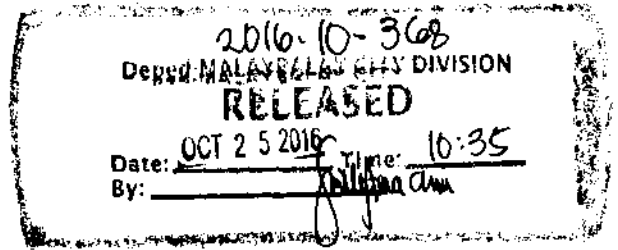

## I. DOCU KALIKASAN

1. Only one (1) entry per school shall participate.
2. The group shall be composed of three (3) members.
3. Video documents shall revolve around the theme.
4. Entries should be submitted together with the registration form to the secretariat. The group must prepare 3 copies of entry in DVD format.
5. The presentation should last for a minimum of five (5) minutes and a maximum of eight (8) minutes. Overtime shall be deducted 1% per minute from the overall grade of the entry.
6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria :

<b>Message/ Content</b>	<b>40%</b>
<b>Narrative Flow</b>	<b>20%</b>
<i>Is the narrative/story original, compelling and interesting? Did it proceed seamlessly?</i>	
<b>Visual Composition/ Cinematography</b>	<b>20%</b>
<i>Did the film show good and creative visual composition/cinematography (camera angles, camera movement, lighting, framing of shots)?</i>	
<b>Audibility</b>	<b>10%</b>
<i>Did the film possess good sound quality and good use of music for soundtrack?</i>	
<b>Editing and Visual Enhancements</b>	<b>10%</b>
<i>Is the video edited properly and of good quality? Is there an appropriate use of visual enhancements ( transitions, titles, credits and special effects)?</i>

2. Science oriented presentation
