SUBJECT: Bridging the Learning Gaps through Supplementary Developmental Activities in Basic English and Mathematical Concepts for ALS A&E Secondary Learners: A Training Workshop for (A&E) Secondary Learners

1. Pursuant to the DepEd Order 24, s. 2015 re: "Guidelines on the Implementation of Bottom-Up Budgeting Projects", the DepEd is one of the participating agencies in the implementation of Bottom-Up-Budgeting (BUB). This office hereby conducts the "**Bridging the Learning Gaps through Supplementary Developmental Activities in Basic English and Mathematical Concepts for ALS A&E Secondary Learners: A Training Workshop**" for (A&E) Secondary Learners on **December 27-29, 2016** at **Loizas Pavilion, Casisang Malaybalay City**

2. This training aims to bridge the learning gaps of ALS learners in preparation for their integration into the formal school system, into the field of work, or to whatever exit that they may choose. There are three major topics to be discussed in this activity namely: (1) Oral Communication Skills (including Public Speaking); (2) Grammar and Formal Letter Writing; and (3) Mathematical Problem Solving. Thus activity will enable the learner participants to be enriched with knowledge and skills that they may not encounter in the ordinary ALS Learning sessions.
