AN ORDER SUSPENDING THE AFTERNOON CLASSES TODAY (FEBRUARY 16, 2017) IN PRE-SCHOOL, ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL LEVELS IN ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS DUE TO PERSISTENT AND HEAVY RAINFALL

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 66, Series of 2012 authorized local chief executives of local government units to suspend classes on both public and private schools in the event of serious weather disturbance affecting their locality;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the said Executive Order allows a local chief executive as chairman of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) to cancel or suspend classes in the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA;

WHEREAS, due to persistent and heavy rainfall prevailing in the City of Malaybalay, there is a need to suspend the **afternoon** classes today (February 16, 2017) in all public and private pre-school, elementary and secondary levels within the City of Malaybalay to ensure the safety of pupils and students

NOW THEREFORE, I, IGNACIO W. ZUBIRI, Mayor of the City of Malaybalay, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the suspension of **afternoon** classes today (February 16, 2017) in preschool, elementary and secondary levels in all private and public schools within the City of Malaybalay.
