REGIONAL CELEBRATION OF 2017 WORLD TEACHERS' DAY

To: Schools Division Superintendents
This Region

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Region X will hold a Regional Celebration of 2017 World Teachers' Day on October 6, 2017 at The Atrium, Limketkai Center, Cagayan de Oro City.

2. This is in line with the Department of Education's celebration of the **National Teachers' Month (NTM)** from September 5 to October 5, 2017, which is also the **National Teachers' Day (NTD)** and **World Teachers' (WTD)**. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242 entitled *Declaring the Period from September 5 to October 5 of Every Year as "National Teachers' Month", as well as Republic Act No. 10743 entitled, An Act Declaring the Fifth day of October of Every Year as the National Teachers' Day*, and the designation of the World Teachers' Day every 5th day of October by the United Nations Education and Cultural Organizations (UNESCO).

3. This year's theme is Gurong Pilipino: Kaakbay sa Progreso

4. The Celebration aims to:

- a. honor those who are in the teaching profession;
- b. acknowledge and give emphasis on the crucial role, loyal service, and dedicated commitment of teachers in developing globally-minded citizens, nurturing families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
- c. revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in the Philippine society;

- d. take the occasion as an opportunity in building the image of teaching as an attractive and fulfilling profession;
- e. generate widespread support and assistance for teachers; and
- f. express gratitude for the positive influences of teachers on Filipino learners.

5. All public and private elementary and secondary schools, including district, schools division and regional offices are advised to follow the synchronized programs and activities (SPAS). On October 5, 2017 school-based celebrations, including the recitation of A Prayer for Teachers or Panalangin Para sa mga Guro shall be observed (*Enclosure A*).

6. In line with this, this Region will hold a Regional Celebration of 2017 World Teachers' Day on October 6, 2017 at The Atrium, Limketkai Center, Cagayan de Oro City.

7. The celebration includes Awarding of Winners of the Search for Outstanding Teacher (I, II and III) and Master Teacher (I and II) for both public and elementary and junior high school levels, ALS Teacher, Mobile Teacher, Multi-grade Teacher, Kindergarten Teacher, Special Education Teacher, IP Teacher, Search for 2017 Ambassador and Ambassadors of Education, Awarding of "Dugong Guro" Best Implementers, Barkada Kontra Droga and showdown of traditional dances around the world presentation and raffling of prizes. Please see *Enclosure II* for the Guidelines on Traditional World Dance Festival Competition and Ambassador and Ambassadors of Education 2017 and *Enclosure III* for the Program of Activities.

8. All expenses relative to the conduct of the celebration shall be charged against local funds or any other source of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- The World Dance Festival Competition is open to Public School Heads, Division/Public School District Supervisors, Functional Chiefs and Superintendents/Asst. Superintendents.
- School Division shall have one entry that will represent to the assigned country depicting their cultural arts (music, dance and costume).
- Each contingent is composed of at least 20 participants and a maximum of 30 participants.
- The participating group shall produce their own canned music. The Compact Disc shall be submitted to the Music Custodian care of REBECCA P. POSTRANO, Education Supervisor of Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) with mobile number 09173270565 and email add , this Office on or before September 29, 2017.
- On the submission of Music, it shall be enclosed with a one page of dance literature for advance knowledge of the Board of Judges.
- The duration of the dance shall be 10 minutes only including entrance & exit and putting up of props. A one (1) point shall be deducted from the consolidated score in excess of every minute.
- Hand props are allowed but not explosive materials.
- Criteria for Judging shall be as follows:

Choreography	-	40%
Costume	-	30%
Mastery	-	20%
Impact	-	<u>10%</u>
TOTAL		100%

- Contestants shall be called one by one and they shall be identified according to their drawn number of performance.

**GUIDELINES ON SEARCH FOR
AMBASSADOR AND AMBASSADRESS OF EDUCATION 2017**

October 6, 2017

Atrium, Lim Ket Kai, Cagayan de Oro City

- The Search for 2017 Ambassador and Ambassadors of Education is open to Public School Teachers from Kindergarten to Grade 12 Level, ages 30 to 40 years old and at least 3 years of teaching.
- Each division shall have two candidates, one (1) for Ambassador and one (1) for Ambassadors meeting the minimum qualifications.
- There shall be three exposures of the candidates, Costume for Traditional World represented, Teacher's Uniform worn on Monday for Male and Female Teachers and Terno for Female and Barong Tagalog for Male. Three will be chosen as Best on Costume for Traditional World (Male and Female), Best in Teacher's Uniform (Male and Female) and Best in Filipiniana Attire (Male and Female).
- Immediately after the Parade of Teachers' Uniform, a short casual interview shall be done where questions shall be drawn out from their Personal Data Sheet.
- After the Third Exposure, Top 5 shall be determined where selection is based from the top scores of Traditional World Costume, Teacher's Uniform, Filipiniana Attire and Casual Interview.
- The Final Selection of the Ambassador and Ambassadors of Education is based on the Final Question and Answer.
- The previous scores shall have no bearing in determining the winners: 4th Runner Up, 3rd Runner Up, 2nd Runner Up, 1st Runner Up and



Ambassador and Ambassadors of Education, thus, Score will go back to Zero.
