4. Create a content package which contains the following:

      1. The video must be at least 2 minutes and a maximum of 3 minutes.
      2. the video must be in good quality
      3. video format AVI
      4. The video must be shot within Malaybalay City
      5. The video must integrate/show the implementation of such advocacy in the respective barangay.
