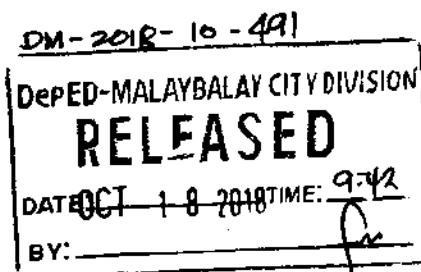

SUBJECT: DIVISION WORKSHOP IN THE FINALIZATION OF REMEDIAL READING ACTIVITIES FOR VOCABULARY DEVELOPMENT, GRAMMAR AWARENESS AND READING COMPREHENSION

1. Relative to the implementation of Malaybalay City Division's **Project READ** (Ready to Engage on Activities for Developing Reading), this Office will conduct a Division Workshop in the Finalization of Remedial Reading Activities for Vocabulary Development, Grammar Awareness and Reading Comprehension on October 24 to 26, 2018 at Loiza's Pavillion, Casisang, Malaybalay City.

2. This activity aims to:

- 2.1 Enhance the developed Remedial Reading Activities on Vocabulary Development, Grammar Awareness and Reading Comprehension for Grades 4 to 10 Classes;
- 2.2 Provide activities that would nurture the English Teachers skills in developing appropriate Manipulative Instructional Materials (mIM) and Work Activities for Remedial Reading in English for Grades 4 to 10 ;
- 2.3 Come up with final copy/ies of **mIm**s for Vocabulary Development, Grammar Awareness and Reading Comprehension for Grades 4 to 10 Classes; and
- 2.4 Strengthen the Project READ Implementation.

3. Participants to this finalization activity are Elementary and Secondary English Teachers who developed Manipulative Instructional Materials (mIMs) on Vocabulary

Development, Grammar Awareness and Reading Comprehension during the Division Enhancement Training conducted on August 3 and 4, 2017 as attached in Enclosure 1.

4. Further, participants are required to bring their enhanced developed mIM , Curriculum Guides For Grades 4 to 10 in English, laptop with extension wire and pocket wifi.
