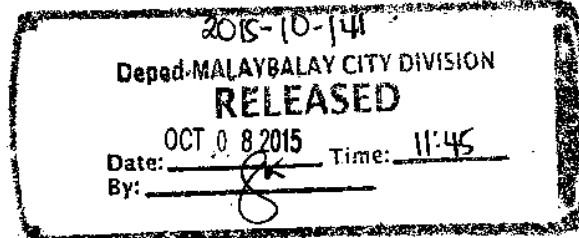

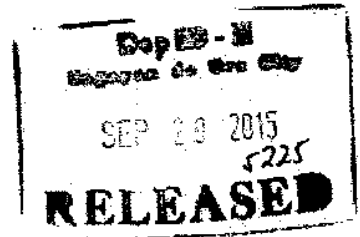

Relative to Department Order No. 111, s. 2009 re: Establishment of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines in the Region, this Office announces the **Renaming of Regional Educational Learning Center (RELC) to National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) X** to be launched during the roll out of School Head Development Program which will be announced later.

To support the Central NEAP, there is a need to establish the NEAP in the Region which shall be responsible in the implementation of programs for the professional development of all regional personnel and to implement and manage region-wide staff development programs pursuant to the national policies and standards.

The NEAP in the Region aims to provide decentralized system of human resources development and management that serves as a hub for quality assurance and accountability to address the peculiar and diverse cultural learning needs at the region and its target clientele resulting in the maximization of resources. Consistent with DepED policies, plans and standards, the NEAP in the Region shall provide technical assistance to its regional organization and all divisions within the Region in the following service areas:

- Training and Development;
- Competency Assessment;
- Quality Assurance and Monitoring & Evaluation and Accreditation (QA-ME-A)
- Research and Development
- Assistance to Succession Planning and Programming; and
- Production of Professional Development Materials (PDMs)

All existing RELC facilities shall now be transferred and converted under the supervision and ownership of the NEAP in the Region. Thus, upgrading of facilities are on- going to cater the needs of the users.

Enclosed is the newly created signage of facilities and the Organizational Structure of the NEAP Staff and Personnel for information and guidance. Further, this Office is hereby requesting your division banner to be hoisted during the launching and this shall be the property of NEAP X.
