

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 10398, entitled Declaring November 25 of every year as National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women (VAW) and Children, the 2013 Annual 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women will be conducted with the theme End VAW Now! It is our Data from November 25 to December 12, 2013.
- 2. The Campaign aims to encourage government agencies to lead other stakeholders in organizing consciousness-raising activities on the elimination of all forms of violence against women (VAW).
