1. Four(4) big High Schools from the Division of Malaybalay participated during the EEC – LeadCom Project Development workshop last January 19, 2013 at COA, Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City. Participants were the LeadCom trained facilitators and 2 student leaders per school. The workshop has provided them with the ideals on conceptualizing projects to address problems on their communities.
