1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1385 entitled Designating the Period from February 14-20, 1975 and every year Thereafter as Retarded Children's Week, this Office will celebrate the 2013 National Intellectual Disability Week with a theme "**Towards Dignity and Quality of Life or *Tungu sa Marangal at Makabuluhang Pamumuhay.***"
2. All Schools especially those with Special Education (SPED) programs are encouraged to conduct any of the following suggested school-based activities during the week:
 - a. inviting the public to visit schools and classes or other educational service providers for children and youth with intellectual disability;
 - b. conducting advocacy campaign in radio and television shows featuring children and youth with intellectual disability as self-advocates to speak about their success;
 - c. conducting dialogue with parents, service providers and stakeholders;
 - d. discuss best practices in the classrooms, school, and community parents, teachers meeting;
 - e. hold cultural shows, sportfest, photo and work exhibits featuring children's potential and capabilities;
 - f. organizing Camp Pag-Ibig, an annual day camp for children with intellectual disability.
3. All activities to be undertaken should not disrupt regular classes nor compromise their instructional supervision pursuant to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled ***Instituting Measure to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.*** Activities which are community-based should be conducted during Saturday and Sunday of the week.
