**ENHANCEMENT OF THE DIVISION ESSENTIAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAM
(EHCP) IMPLEMENTATION**

To: Education Program Supervisors/Coordinators
Public Schools District Supervisor
Elementary and Secondary School Heads
This Division

1. To ensure quality of implementation of Essential Health Care Program in conformity with DepED Order no. 65 s. 2009 re: **IMPLEMENTATION OF ESSENTIAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAM (EHCP) FOR THE SCHOOL CHILDREN**, this Office has identified six (6) schools which shall serve as the **EHCP District/Division model schools for SY 2013-2014**.

2. These schools which shall showcase its **"BEST PRACTICES"** and program efficiency in line with **School-Based Management (SBM)** principles i.e.:


SCHOOL	DISTRICT
1-BCT ELEM. SCHOOL	Malaybalay City Central District
2- MIGLAMIN ELEM. SCHOOL	Malaybalay City East District
3- KILAP-AGAN ELEM. SCHOOL	Malaybalay City North District
4- MACOTE ELEM. SCHOOL	Malaybalay City South District
5- AIRPORT VILLAGE ELEM. SCHOOL	Malaybalay City West District
6- ST PETER ELEM. SCHOOL	Malaybalay City Far East District

3. Implementing guidelines of Essential Health Care Program stipulates:

- a. Common **FUNCTIONAL Handwashing/Toothbrushing** facility which can simultaneously accommodate **7-10 pupils** be provided.
- b. Availability of an acceptable and sturdy **Toothbrush Holder** with proper labeling.
- c. Integration of **Daily Group Handwashing and Toothbrushing** in Classroom Program with updated activity Checklist.

4. Moreover, it is reiterated that **ALL elementary/secondary schools** in this Division should conform with DepED Order no. 56, s. 2009 “**IMMEDIATE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER AND HAND WASHING FACILITIES IN ALL SCHOOLS FOR THE PREVENTION OF INFLUENZA A (H1N1)**”.

5. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance with this memorandum is enjoined.
