- 1. - 3. Implementing guidelines of Essential Health Care Program stipulates:
- a. Common FUNCTIONAL Handwashing/Toothbrushing facility which can simultaneously accommodate 7-10 pupils be provided.
 - b. Availability of an acceptable and sturdy Toothbrush Holder with proper labeling.
 - c. Integration of Daily Group Handwashing and Toothbrushing in Classroom Program with updated activity Checklist.

- 4. Moreover, it is reiterated that ALL elementary/secondary schools in this Division should conform with DepED Order no. 56, s. 2009 "IMMEDIATE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER AND HAND WASHING FACILITIES IN ALL SCHOOLS FOR THE PREVENTION OF INFLUENZA A (H1N1).
