**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

**SPORTS, LITERARY AND TALENT COMPETITION**  
(In-line with the celebration of 2013 World Day Against Child labor  
– Provincial Level)

**To : Education Program Supervisors/ Division Coordinators - Designates**

**School Focal Persons in Child Labor Programs**

1. The field is hereby informed that the Provincial Child Labor Committee headed by the Committee Chairman **PSWD Officer Arsenio L. Alagenio** of the Provincial Social Welfare and Development together with the Child Labor Program Implementer from the Department of Education, Divisions of Malaybalay City, Bukidnon and Valencia City convened on June 06, 2013 at Valencia City National High School, Valencia City, Bukidnon for a regular bi-monthly meeting.
2. Excerpts from the minutes of the said meeting were the following:
  - 2.1. **On July 11 – 12, 2013, A Sports, Literary and Talent Competition for Child Laborers will be conducted in line with the Celebration of 2013 World Day Against Child Labor (WDACL) with the theme: "No to Child Labor in Domestic Work"**. Activity shall starts at 9:00am on the first day and shall end on 3:00pm on the second day following the issued format and sequence of activities reflected in the Opening Program, Awarding/Closing Ceremony and in the Literary and Talent Night. (Enclosed)
  - 2.2. This event will be participated in by International Labour Organization – International Programme on the Elimination of Child labor (ILO-IPEC), Provincial Government of Bukidnon, Local Government Units of Malaybalay City, Valencia City, Maramag and Quezon, Department of Education Divisions of Bukidnon, Malaybalay City and Valencia City and Provincial Child labor Committee of the Provincial Child Welfare Council.

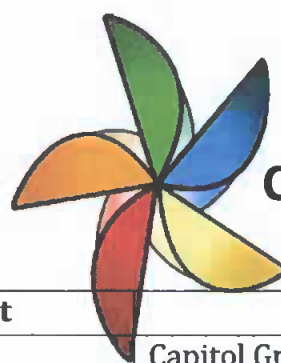
- 2.3. The different events as planned will be held at Provincial Capitol Ground, Barangay 9 Covered Court and Kaamulan Open Theater, Malaybalay City, Bukidnon.
- 2.4. Tapped players for this event shall be the in-school child laborers who are currently enrolled in elementary and high school both formal and ALS in thirteen (13) ILO-IPEC barangays based on Direct Beneficiary Monitoring Report of ILO-IPEC. **For the Division of Malaybalay City, the participation of the child laborers is limited to the target elementary schools and secondary high schools of Barangay San Jose, Linabo and Managok, Malaybalay City. No athlete is allowed to play without duly signed parents' permit.**
- 2.5. As requested by the **PSWD Committee, the School Principal II of the Malaybalay City Central School Mrs. Antoinette Reburiano is in-charge of assigning eight (8) classrooms to be used as sleeping/cooking quarters** of the four (4) delegations namely: Municipality of Quezon, Maramag, Valencia City and Malaybalay City during the conduct of the activity. Provision of beddings, mattresses, cooking and dining utensils is under the responsibility and accountability of each delegation team.
- 2.6. **The Government issued service vehicles (L3) of Malaybalay City Central and East Districts (with the approval of the PSDSs)** shall be used in transporting the Malaybalay City team in attending and going back to their respective point of origin.
3. The total number of participants allotted by the PSWDO including the DepED personnel and assisting staff for our division is sixty (60). The breakdown and the specific events to be played are shown below.

5. For the musical and literary night, there will be three (3) judges for the whole duration. Each division will be represented by one (1) judge. **Mrs. Lou-Ann J. Cultura, the Education Program Supervisor in MAPEH of Malaybalay City Division is the appointed Chairman of the Board of Judges** by the Committee. Judges will base their scoring on the agreed and approved criteria for judging. (Enclosed)
6. The food appropriation per delegation team charged to the Provincial Child labor Program includes four (4) meals and four (4) snacks to be served during the conduct of the two-day activity.
7. For the team's uniform, each player and DepED personnel appearing on the official note shall be given one (1) free uniform.
8. Active participation and full support of the Division Child Labor Program Focal Persons, District Alternative Learning System (ALS) Coordinators, Instructional Managers, Sports Coordinators, Coaches and staff is highly encouraged and enjoined.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
