

- 1. In view of the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) issues the following Ciarifications on the Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the Language Learning Areas and their Time Allotment in Grades 1 and 2 as stated in the Enclosure Nos. 1 and 2 of DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2012:
 - a. Mother Tongue is used as a Medium of Instruction (MOI) for Grades 1 and 2 in teaching Mathematics, Araling Panlipunan (AP), Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH) and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP);
 - b. Mother Tongue is taught as a separate Learning Area in Grades 1 and 2;
 - c. Pilipino, as a Learning Area, is first introduced in Grade 1 during the second quarter (2nd Q)/grading period;
 - d. English, as a Learning Area, is first introduced in Grade 1 during the third quarter (3rd Q)/grading period; and
 - e. Time allotment for the Learning Areas is specified below:
