

#### • MECHANICS of the CHEER- DANCE CONTEST:

1. There are only four (4) competing teams, namely:

Team A (Green) - Central & Far East Districts
Team B (Blue) - North & South Districts
Team C (Red) - East & West Districts
Team D (Yellow) - Secondary Schools

- 2. Each team must have at least 20 to 30 members, mixed, with at least 8 -12 males in a group.
- 3. The contest is limited to cheer and dance only. No pyramids. No flyers.
- 4. Costumes of participants must be simple and in decent form. Use of props (Pompoms) will be tolerated to add festive mood, however, Pyrotechnics and other hazardous or dangerous props is strictly prohibited.
- 5. Each group is given 5 to 8 minutes to perform including entrance and exit. Two (2) points will be added to the final rank of each team for every minute or fraction thereof that will exceed to the time allotted. Timers are commissioned by the organizer to do the task.
- 6. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

#### 7. Criteria for Judging:

a. Mastery - 40%
- Coordination
- Precise execution
b. Choreography - 30%
- Clarity of formation
- Fluidity of steps
- Special effects
c. Costume & Props - 20%
d. Over-all impact - 10%
