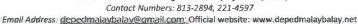

### MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 05 Series of 2012

#### GUIDELINES ON THE ISSUANCE OF OMBUDSMAN CLEARANCE

SECTION 1. Rationale. Consistent with the constitutional provisions on accountability of public officers and in line with the statutory mandate of the Office of the Outhudsman on the enforcement of administrative, civil and criminal liability of public officers, the following set of guidelines in the issuance of Ombudsman Clearance is issued to set up control mechanisms in preserving the integrity of the Ombudsman Clearance as an official document used in the processing of appointments, promotions, retirements, transfers, resignations, mevels, grant of service awards and scholarships in the public service, and for other purposes.

SEC. 2. Ombudsman Clearence. Defined. An Ombudsman Clearence is an official document certifying that a person has no criminal, administrative and forficiant case/s pending with the Office of the Ombudsman.

A case is deared pending from the time it has been docketed as a criminal, administrative or forfeiture case until a resolution or decision thereof has attained finality in accordance with the rules or, in case of an adverse disposition, the penalty imposed therein has been duly served or fully implemented.

If there appears to be such pending case against the applicant, the Office shall instead issue a Certification that he or size has pending criminal, administrative or forfeiture case/s filed with the Office of the Ombudsman.

A complaint that is under case build-up or fact-finding investigation, however, shall not be considered a pending case.

SEC. 3. Procedure. The following regulations shall be observed in processing applications or requests for issuance of Ombudaman Clearance:

#### A. Who may file:

1. Any person may file an application for his or her own Ombudsmac Clearance personally or through a duly sushorized representative.

2. Heads of departments, offices, agencies, bureaus, or their duly authorized representatives, with respect to their own personnel or under the terms of existing memorands of appearant.

3. Chairpersons or duly anthonized representatives of the Judicial and Bar Council, Commission on Appointments and other search and selection committees or bodies, as to their respective applicants/nominees.

Ombudamen officials and employees are prohibited from filing and following up applications on behalf of applicants.

#### Requirements:

- 1. Duly accomplished Application for Ombudaman Clearance (see Annax "A"; downloadable from Office website), if filed by the applicant mentioned in A1; or a formal request addressed to the Ombudaman, if filed by the requester enumerated in A2 and A3;
- Original or certified true copy of the Service Record with a statement of the date of retirement/resignation, or, where applicable, the personal data or information sheet;
- Government-issued ID of the applicant, and the duly anthorized representative under A. I where applicable; and
- Payment of the processing fee, as may be determined and authorized under pertinent issuezoes.

#### C. When and Where to File:

An application or request for issuance of Ombudeman Clearance may be filed at any time, except that, for retirement purposes, an application shall be filed not earlier than six (6) months prior to the date of retirement of the applicant.

An application for Ombudemen Clearence may be filed with any of the following offices or in such other offices as may be established:

- 1. Office of the Ombudemen Central Office Quezon City
- 2. Office of the Deputy Ombudaman for Visayes Cebu
- 3. Office of the Deputy Ombudanten for Vienyas Iloilo Regional Office
- 4. Office of the Deputy Ombudaman for Vissyes Texioban Regional Office
- 5. Office of the Deputy Ombudamen for Mindaman Devac
- Office of the Deputy Ombidsman for Mindenso Cagayar De Oro Regional Office
- 7. Via on-line at www.ombudsmen.gov.ph

An Ombudamen Cleanance may be personally claimed at any of the offices enumerated under C.1 to C.6. The elserance may also be sent through regular mail or pre-paid private courier service.

or employee, which may be subject only to any claim that the paying agency may have against the public official or employee.

SEC. 7. Transitory Provisions. This Memorandum Circular shall prospectively apply to applications/requests filed upon effectivity hereof. Pending applications/requests, if any, shall be acted upon under this Memorandum Circular insofar as it is beneficial to the applicam/requester.

Until such time that the assessment of processing fees have been determined and authorized under pertinent issuances pursuant to Section 4, the requirement under Section 3(B)(4) shall be suspended and the processing of the application/request shall momentarily be free of charge.

SEC. 8. Repealing Clause. All previous issuences inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 9. Effectivity Clause. This Memorandum Circular shall take effect on December 01, 2012 after fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and upon filing of three (3) certified copies thereof with the University of the Philippines Law Center.

#### D. Contents of the Clonensee/Cartification:

1. The Ombudymen Clearance shell state the:

- name of the person subject of the ciearance and, where applicable, his/her agency;
- b. name of the applicant/requester and the agracy represented, if any;

c. specific pumpse the which the cleanage is sought; and

- d. adverse disposition of any terminated case against the person subject of the electrones, and a statement that the penalty therein imposed had been duly served or fally implemented.
- Meanwhile, the Certification shall, in addition to those listed in Section
   3.D.1 (a) to (c), contain the following data about his or her pending case:
  - z. éncket muniter,
  - b. title of the case;
  - c. specific charge/s; and
  - d. status of the case and implementation of the imposed penalty, if any.
- SEC. 4. Processing Fee. As may be allowed under partinent issuances, processing fees that be charged for the reasonable cost attending the processing of Ombudemen Clearances and Certifications. The Assistant Ombudemen for finance shall endy and recommend the schedule of processing fees to be charged.
- SEC. 5. Algoratories. Unless modified by the Ombudaman through pertinent issuances, the following are the officials sutherized to oversee the processing of and validate/sign Ombudaman Clearences and Certifications:
  - 1. Ombudemen Central Office/ Luzon/ Military Other Law Enforcement Offices:
    - a Public Assistance and Corruption Provendon Office (PACPO) Assistant
      Ombudemen
    - b. Public Assistance Bureau (PAB) Director
    - c. Designated FAB officer
  - 2. Combudsman Visayas:
    - c. Deputy Occidedance for Visayes
    - b. Head of the Fublic Assistance bureau/quit
    - c Chief of the Administrative Division
  - 3. Ombudenser Måndanao:
    - a. Deputy Ombudanen for Mindaneo
    - b. Head of the Public Assistance burezu/unit
    - c. Chief of the Asiministrative Division
- SEC. 6. Miscelleneous Provision. No Ombudamen Clearance or Cartification is required for the payment of the monetized value of the accused leave credits of a separated public official
