TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATIONS**

1. Pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 155, s. 2013 *re: 2013 National Teachers' Month and World Teachers' Day Celebrations*, the Department of Education (DepEd) will celebrate the **National Teachers' Month (NTM)** during the whole month of September starting September 5, 2013, and will culminate during the **World Teachers' Day (WTD)** celebration on October 5, 2013, with the theme *My Teacher, My Hero*.

2. The celebrations aim to:

- a. highlight the unique role, service, and commitment that teachers play in guiding families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
- b. revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in the Philippine society and in national development;
- c. use the occasion to encourage everyone to contribute in making teaching an attractive profession and in giving teachers the needed support and assistance;
- d. generate widespread support for teaches in particular and for education in general; and
- e. express sincere gratitude for the positive influences of teachers on Filipino learners.

3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools, including division and district offices, are enjoined to follow the Synchronized Programs, Projects, and Activities which are actively lead by the heads of the offices/schools. Since October 5 falls on a Saturday, school-based celebrations may be anticipated and held on October 4. However, district and division celebrations must be held on October 5.

4. This Office has lined up activities to highlight the celebrations.

6. All expenses relative to NTM and WTD shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. All schools and district offices are required to post streamers to ensure that the public is aware of the NTM and WTD celebrations. 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242 signed by His Excellency President Benigno S. Aquino III on August 24, 2011 and to the designation of October 5 as **World Teachers' Day (WTD)** by the United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), the Department of Education (DepEd) will celebrate the **National Teachers' Month (NTM)** during the whole month of September starting on September 5, 2013 and will culminate during the World Teachers' Day (WTD) celebration on October 5, 2013, with the theme *My Teacher, My Hero*.

2. The Celebrations aim to:

- a. highlight the unique role, service, and commitment that teachers play in guiding families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
- b. revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in the Philippine society and in national development;
- c. use the occasion to encourage everyone to contribute in making teaching an attractive profession and in giving teachers the needed support and assistance;
- d. generate widespread support for teachers in particular and for education in general; and
- e. express sincere gratitude for the positive influences of teachers on Filipino learners.

3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools, including division and regional offices, are enjoined to follow the Synchronized Programs, Projects, and Activities. Since October 5 falls on a Saturday, school-based celebrations, including the recitation of *A Prayer for Teachers* or *Panalangin Para sa mga Guro*, may be anticipated and held on October 4. However, district, division, regional, and national celebrations must be held on October 5. All expenses relative to NTM and WTD shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

4. All school heads, district supervisors, schools division/city superintendents (SDSs), and regional directors (RDs) are enjoined to actively lead all activities for NTM and WTD.

5. All schools and district, division, regional, and central offices are required to post streamers to ensure that the public is aware of the NTM and WTD celebrations. The digital files of the new streamer designs may be downloaded from [www.facebook.com/DepEd.Philippines](http://www.facebook.com/DepEd.Philippines) and [www.facebook.com/depedtmc](http://www.facebook.com/depedtmc).

6. In accordance with the Synchronized Programs, Projects, and Activities, all SDSs and RDs are required to submit their respective plans, foremost of which is the conduct of their respective culminating activity on **October 5, 2013**, where officials from the DepEd CO will be assigned to attend. SDSs and RDs are also required to submit the names and contact numbers of their respective division and regional coordinator for the NTM and WTD celebrations. These requirements shall be submitted on or before **August 31, 2013** to DepEd-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) through email address: [cscaportal@gmail.com](mailto:cscaportal@gmail.com) for coordination and monitoring purposes.

7. Reports on the activities conducted by the schools, districts, divisions, and regions shall include clear photos and a comprehensive documentation of the various activities. These reports, including announcements, greetings, and others, shall be posted at [www.facebook.com/DepEd.Philippines](http://www.facebook.com/DepEd.Philippines) and [www.facebook.com/depedtmc](http://www.facebook.com/depedtmc) for two months (September and October 2013).

8. Compliance with the abovementioned requirements and the Synchronized Programs, Projects, and Activities for NTM and WTD shall be strictly monitored by the Office of the Undersecretary for Partnerships and External Linkages.

**PROCLAMATION NO. 242**

**DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM 05 SEPTEMBER TO 05 OCTOBER OF EVERY YEAR AS "NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH"**

**WHEREAS**, the United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) designated 05 October of every year as "World Teachers' Day," which is a day to celebrate the central role that teachers play in guiding the children, youth and adults through the life-long learning process;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to generate widespread awareness and support for World Teachers' Day here in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, it is essential to revitalize the image of teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in Philippine society and national development;

**WHEREAS**, the occasion can be used to celebrate the unique role and service that teachers play in guiding families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;

**WHEREAS**, to contribute to the growth and development of the teaching profession in the country as well as to publicly express appreciation to teachers, both active and retired, a Teachers' Month Campaign (TMC) was conceived in July 2008 by the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), De la Salle Philippines (DSLP), Philippine Business for Education (PBE), and Campaigns Social Response (CSR), with the special participation of the Department of Education (DepEd) and the support of key business institutions;

**WHEREAS**, owing to its success, the Campaign has generated more support from government, private companies, and major organizations in 2009 and 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Proclamation No. 41 (s. 2010) declared the first Friday of September to 05 October 2010 as National Teachers' Month.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the period from 05 September to 05 October of every year as "**National Teachers' Month**."

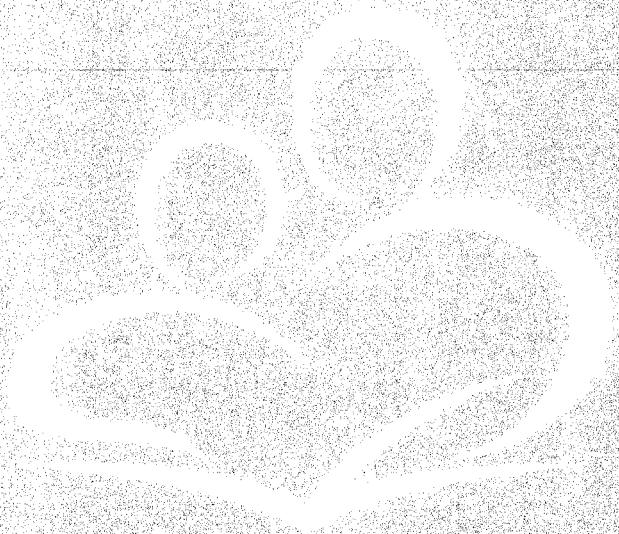
