# CONDUCT OF THE DIVISION SPED FESTIVAL OF TALENTS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2013-2014

- Pursuant to Unnumbered Regional Memorandum from the Office of the Regional Director dated May 8, 2013 re: Regional Integrated Competition, this Office will conduct a Division Special Education (SPED) Festival of Talents for public and private schools with the theme "Kakayahan: Kayang-kaya kahit may Kapansanan" on October 8, 2013 at Malaybalay City Central School Gymnasium, Malaybalay City.
- 2. The competition aims to:
  - a. Provide opportunities for children and students with special needs to show their talents;
  - b. Showcase the potentials of children and students with special needs in strengthening their confidence and self-esteem;
  - c. Enhance the physical, social, emotional, intellectual and spiritual development of children and students with special needs;
- 3. The contest categories are as follows: (see attached guidelines and mechanics)

- 4. Each district should be represented by Public and Private Schools.
- 5. Registration is free. Travelling expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local/school/PTA funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- General guidelines as discussed and committees/judges as agreed, during the meeting of Special Education School Coordinator last September 6, 2013 for the conduct of Division SPED Festival of Talents is enclosed for guidance and information.

# General Guidelines for the Conducts of the Regional SPED Festival of Talents (RSPEDFT)

# Theme: "Kakayahan: Kayang-kaya kahit may Kapansanan"

- 1. Each District both public and private schools shall conduct their own competitions to select the best contestants in all categories.
- 2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled in SPED classes pupils/students in public schools aged 5-25 years old.
- 3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
- 4. Only the District champions per category are qualified to join the contest.
- 5. Coach in each category is required to submit a certified true copy of contestant's birth certificate, 2x2 ID pictures, IEP, certification from the Principal that the child is currently enrolled in the school and parents permit to join the contest.
- 6. The number of each contestant in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.
- 7. There will be a common contest piece or one theme for drawing while the contestant in vocal solo/duet is given the freedom to choose their own piece in English/Filipino/MTB.
- 8. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
- 9. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges.
- 10. All winners will be determined thru point system.

Total points garnered in each group (public/private) shall be consolidated to get the overall champion.

11. All winners will receive medals 1<sup>st</sup> – Gold, 2<sup>nd</sup> – Silver, 3<sup>rd</sup> – Bronze while the Over-all Champions will receive cash prize as follows:

12. The panel of judges shall be composed of a Chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.

## A. VOCAL SOLO/DUET COMPETITION (VISUAL IMPAIRMENT)

## **Elementary Category**

- 1. Each contestant is free to choose any song appropriate to children.
- 2. Performance time is 2-3 minutes including entrance and exit.
- 3. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used as accompaniment; however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.

## INTERPRETATIVE DANCE COMPETITION (HEARING IMPAIRMENT)

- A. Elementary Category (Creative Dance Sports)
- B. Secondary Category (Folk Dance)
  - 1. The group is composed of at least minimum of two (2) pairs and maximum of five (5) pairs, 5 males and 5 females but should not exceed 12 members.
  - 2. Each participating group will create a dance depicting a certain sports of their choice. Example if they choose basketball, their steps should include dribbling, shooting, throwing and catching.
  - 3. Time of performance should not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.
