

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 155, s. 2013 entitled 2013 National Teachers' Month and World Teachers' Day Celebrations, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) and Smart Communications, Inc., will conduct the National Teachers' Month and World Teachers' Day Nationwide Photo-Essay-Writing Contest.

2013 DepEd-Smart National Teachers' Month and World Teachers' Day Nationwide Photo-Essay-Writing Contest

CONTEST MECHANICS

I. RATIONALE

Smart Communications Inc. has once again partnered with the Department of Education through the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs in the conduct of various contests nationwide in support of the National Teacher's Month and World Teacher's Day celebrations.

DepEd and Smart Communications Inc. recognize that the lasting contributions of a teacher to the development of a student is still very important today as it was ages ago. The love of learning that they instill in their students is a valuable gift that lasts a lifetime.

Through these contests, and with the help of social media, teachers will get the recognition and appreciation they so deserve on their special day. More so, we will be able to highlight our teachers' far-reaching and profound influence in our society being the front-liners of education and learning.

Being online contests, the pupils', students' and teachers' outputs can be shared easily with friends, family and the community, making our teachers' day celebrations as widely observed as Mother's Day and Father's Day. This will also help build awareness and support for the National Teachers' Month and World Teachers' Day.

II. THEME

The theme for the contest is "My Teacher, My Hero."

III. OBJECTIVES

The contest seeks to achieve the following objectives:

- A. To encourage elementary pupils, high school students and teachers to creatively express, through social media, how much they honor and value their current or former teachers; and,
- B. To instill awareness and drum up support for the National Teachers' Month and World Teachers' Day celebration.

IV. CONTEST GUIDELINES

A. General Guidelines

- 1. The contest is open to Elementary Pupils, High School Students and Teachers from both public and private schools nationwide.
- 2. Each school may submit strictly up to two (2) entries only per category as applicable. Should there be more than two (2) entries per category, the school shall select from among the entries.

- 3. All entries of a school must be sent together in one email.
- 4. Entries must be original, recent and unpublished.
- 5. The following must be submitted together with the entry, duly certified by the school head or principal:
 - a. Title of the Entry
 - b. Complete Name of the Contestant
 - c. Contact Number, preferably mobile
 - d. Home Address
 - e. Grade/Year Level (for pupil or student)
 - f. Designation/Position (for teachers)
 - g. Name of School
 - h. School's Contact Number
 - i. School Address
 - j. Twitter Account Name (must be a public account)
 - k. Facebook Account Name (must be searchable)
 - I. Full name of the teacher in the picture and his/her whereabouts if known. State whether the teacher is still in service, retired or deceased.
 - m. A scanned Certification/Honor Pledge of the School Head that the participant is a bonafide pupil/student/teacher of the school; that the entry was specifically made by the pupil/student/teacher of the school for this contest; and that the entry has not been submitted to other similar contest/s.
- 6. Entries must be sent to **myteacher_myhero@yahoo.com**. Indicate in the subject field your school's name followed by the category. (example: Quezon City Science High School Elementary Teacher Category).
- 7. Only entries with complete information and sent to the specified email address will be deemed valid.
- 8. All contest materials submitted shall be the property of the organizers.
- 9. Decision of the Judges is final and irrevocable.

B. Specific Guidelines

- 1. There will be four (4) categories for this contest, namely:
 - a. Elementary Pupil Category
 - b. Elementary Teacher Category
 - c. High School Student Category
 - d. High School Teacher Category
- Contestants shall take a photo together with his/her teacher that he/she regards as significant to his/her life. Old photos may also be used for this purpose as long as the contestant is together with his/her teacher in the photo.
- The photo must be digitally taken in JPEG format and must be set in the highest possible resolution of the camera. Old photos may be digitally scanned.
- 4. The photo's file name shall be the name of the school followed by the category. (example: Manila Science High School Elementary Teacher Category)
- 5. Complete the phrase "#ifnotformyteacher..." with a maximum of 90 characters or less including spaces. This will serve as a caption to the photo. (example: #ifnotformyteacher I won't be able to achieve success in life. #SmartTeachers #thankyouteacher)
- 6. Tweet the photo with the 90-character caption including hashtags #SmartTeachers and #thankyouteacher.

- 7. Develop the caption into a short essay consisting only of three (3) paragraphs with a maximum of 500 words.
- 8. Submit the photo with caption, short essay and the rest of the required information to email address **myteacher_myhero@yahoo.com**. Send your entry only once and wait for a confirmation reply. If we are unable to confirm receipt of your entry within three (3) days, resend your entry.
- 9. Valid and compliant entries will be uploaded to the following Facebook Pages for public viewing and verification purposes by the contestants:

V. JUDGING

Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Relevance to the Theme	25%
Caption and Essay	35%
Overall Impact	15%
