**REGIONAL MASS TRAINING FOR GRADE 2 AND 8 TEACHERS ON K-12 BASIC

This Division

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 44, s. 2013, the Regional Office will conduct the Regional Mass Training for Grade 2 and 8 Teachers on April and May 2013 in preparation for the implementation of the K-12 Basic Education Program.-
2. The training aims to:
 - a. provide teachers with a concrete understanding of the Grade 2 and 8 Curriculum Framework, learning standards and competencies, assessment and teaching plan;
 - b. provide them with opportunity to acquire and demonstrate the values that will guide the teachers in the effective delivery of the curriculum and their role as facilitators of learning.
3. Participants of this Training are all Grade 2 and Grade 8 teachers in public elementary and secondary schools of this Division.
4. The schedule, venue and guidelines of the training and assigned teacher Education Institution (TEIs) for Grade 8 are contained in the following enclosures.

5. Meals and accommodation of all participants shall be charged to the TEI's while travelling and other expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
