We are most pleased to inform you that Defending Family Values Foundation (DFV), Alalay sa Familya at Bayan Foundation (APB), and University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) intend to hold a CACHET summit strategic planning conference, scheduled for Friday, 13 September 2013, from 7:30 A M to 5:30 P.M. at the Xavier Sports & Country Club, Cagayan de Oro City. You are most cordially invited to send 3-legates from your jurisdiction to this activity.

We suggest that the participants come from three schools per division, to be chosen by your office. The intention is that each of the three regional representative schools is to be requested to send two (2) high school students, one (1) high school teacher, one (1) parent, and the school principal, for a total of five (5) per school. The schools division superintendents or the assistant is most welcome to attend as well.

CACHET, which stands for Campaign for Character Education Tenacity is a program jointly nandled by the above-mentioned emitties. Essentially, the campaign is a continuing search for exemplars of public high schools, identified and assessed on the basis of specific criteria areas: a) noteworthiness equalitative effectiveness) of existing character education programs; b) scholastic competence of students and faculty; c) solidarity of students, as manifested in their collaboration with the school in character education; d) collaboration of parents in the education of their children and in the life of the school, and e) good governance (management and administration), particularly of the character education thrust and programs

Using the framework of school accreditation developed by the Ford Foundation-UA&P Project Serling Silver inclusive of a self-survey instrument and peer verification, the Cachet Schools Search and Avard, would thus be the contribution of the private sector to encouraging quality and sustainability among public high schools, and eventually, all schools in the country.

The planning conference seeks to be a consultative exercise to give flesh to the search. We have successfully conducted one recently for the NCR. We enclose the proposed schedule of the conference for activities for the students, on one hand, and the educators, on the other hand.

NO REGISTRATION FEES will be charged for the summit. We thus request that the expenses of participants to and from their stations be made chargeable to available funds in the schools.

We hope you find this request worth your favor. As stated in the brief below, "character education is the most indispensable element of the effectiveness and efficiency of the nation's education system and programs.
