It is encouraged also to document activities through video. On the other hand, each Division is required to endorse one elementary and secondary school as the Best Implementer of the 2014 Summer Reading Camp, in which these official winners per division are to be recognized during ht eRegional Celebration on Education Week for SY 2014-2015. The criteria in the selection of nominees in giving recognition to the best implementer are division-based.
